### What to expect from your supervising instructor:

- Meet with the parent/guardian and student 4 times per school quarter (16 total per school year), 2 of these contacts per quarter are to be face to face and 2 of these contacts per quarter are to be non face to face, to discuss and evaluate student learning.
- Advise and assist a parent/guardian to create the best education for each child.
- Make sure parents complete all necessary forms and file them accordingly.
- Order various curriculum and materials for all children.
- Provide enrichment classes, workshops, and educational trips.

### What we expect from you as the parent and homeschool teacher:

- Be the primary educator of their child, responsible for setting and implementing their education plan, selecting materials, and methods to achieve their goals.
- Meet with your supervising instructor to have 4 contacts per school quarter (16 contacts per school year), 2 of these contacts per quarter are to be face to face and 2 of these contacts per quarter are to be non face to face, to discuss, review and evaluate documentation of student learning, according to the Iowa Department of Education.
- Complete and submit all forms and online registration.
- Ensure that your student has completed a minimum of 148 days of educational instruction
- Ensure the student is provided with supplemental resources to utilize for study and research as applicable

### What we expect from you as the homeschooling student:

- The student will complete all assignments that the parent and/or homeschooling teacher assigns
- The student will complete a minimum of 148 days of educational instruction during the year
- The student will follow the lesson plans and detailed assignments, so the student does not fall behind in his/her learning
- The student will use various resources to solve a problem and/or answer questions.
- The student will meet with the advising instructor on a daily to review progress and discuss material. Also, the student will meet with the parent and homeschooling teacher to review progress at least 2 times per quarter.
- The student will spend the majority of the school day learning and completing the necessary requirements for his/her grade level. (i.e., school assignments, school research, educational reading, educational writing, listening to instruction from the parent and/or homeschool teacher, school lesson testing, specials, extracurricular activities, etc.)
