

Sithspawn Profile - "Hes'falda's Watchers"

-Continuously Updated-

Summary

A tomb located on the ancestral homeworld of Korribann, it was styled to resemble the God of Tyranny, Urgak-Val, by the found alchemist within, but was revealed to be a temple for the worship of Hes'Falda - god of deceit and trickery.

It contained two surviving sithspawn, presumably created by the alchemist and the cause of the would-be intruders' deaths. Two live specimens were caught, the second variant singular and disintegrated upon death.

Current status:

The temple entrance is currently under guard by a handful of droids and sithhounds of Sith Sarias, awaiting further exploration by the alchemy branch.

The two live specimens, full report, samples and knowledge are collected below.

Main Attributes

'Eye-Bats'

- **Possess the ability of flight**
- **Able to sense force users**, outright ignoring other lifeforms, in favor of only growing hostile upon sensing the force.
- **Application of 'force wound'**, or something similar in effect. A singular specimen shall not pose a large threat for a singular barrier, though the effect is amplified based on the amount of 'bats' are applying the effect.
- **Lacking internal structure**, many vital organs are absent, lacking any notable skeletal structure with something resembling a carapace. Internals holds many neural connections, likely a design to see them controlled via the helmet, or connect to the 'bale-wolf'.

- **Instinctive targeting**, will all out of instinct focus onto the same target, applying the 'force wounding'.

'Bale-Wolf'

- **Symbiotic relationship with 'eye-bats'**, lacking sensory organs, the 'eye-bats' nestled within the gaps of the body served as its eyes.
- **Telepathic link with 'eye-bats'**, while unconfirmed, it held a connection to the other sithspawn, making them capable of coordinating.
- **Long body and speed**, due to shape of body and guild, it held increased speed and agility, attacking with serrated claws.
- Presumed not to have required food, due to its survival in isolated chambers for very long. Potential hibernation, or limited need of food.

Appearance

'Eye-bats' - Measures 50-60 cm in wingspan, with rounded bodies and a singular eye (which internally resembles two eyes fused together). Lacks most vital organs, but has a protrusion from their backside looking to be a way of "attaching" itself to something - presumably the 'Bale-Wolf'.

'Bale-Wolf' -

Canine in appearance, large enough to contain several of the eye-bats. Suffered from a long period of decay and structural degradation of its body. Presumably it was made with the

cavities in its body, to accommodate the 'eye-bats'. Its primary offense were its serrated claws and speed.

Weaknesses

'Eye-bats'

- **Presumed blind**, only reactive when they sense a presence in the force, and the dampening of one's presence saw them able to be snuck past.
- **Lacking internal skeleton**, lacks any natural defenses, can be dispatched fairly easily if in close range.
- **Reliance on numbers**, singular instances, or few numbers, are easily overcome.
- **Blindfolding**, removing their direct line of sight, breaks their ability to apply 'force wound'.
- **Control Unit**, presumed to be controllable using the recovered helmet (unconfirmed)
- It is theorized to favor isolated groups or targets for its ambush, so its highly suggested one does not split up.

Proposed Timeline (From Sith Zevasa, to be revised if new evidence is found)

"First, that we are not the first to attempt to enter it; the corpses of other Sith indicate that other would-be alchemists, scholars or tomb-divers had attempted to make their way into the central chamber but had died before reaching it".

"Second, that at some point a faction of unknown worshippers made their way into the complex and further damaged statues, adding in painted graffiti".

"Third, that another unknown faction sought to desecrate the temple, shattering statues and removing heads and arms; this appears to be the oldest events we can find evidence of within the tomb".

Sith Alchemist is the presumed caster of the illusion.

Samples recovered

1x Helm of Sith Design, forged Sith Steel - possibly enchanted, properties unknown but presumed to be related to the sithspawn. (Being investigated by Sith Hazlem)

1x Journal, badly damaged, belonging to the creator of the Sithspawn creatures.
