	 Do we have any more kindergarten Field Trips? Nothing planned at this time, but it is not too late for the teachers to plan another one before the end of the school year. How does one increase likelihood of being selected as a field trip chaperone? Make sure to get cleared to volunteer, read communications on Dojo and emails, and proactively let your teacher know. How can someone take advantage of seeing the school counselor? You can ask your child's teacher, click in the newsletter virtual corner, and/or email Ms Arnold at candicea@cmitelementary.org How does the school support TAG identified students? A large number of students are TAG identified at CMIT. At CMIT they do differentiated instruction within the classroom. There are also specific TAG centers that are options for TAG identified students. Can STEM projects have a standard way of being submitted across classrooms? Yes, starting next year, all students will submit to a single form and they will sort it out to the correct teachers. Are poster boards mandatory for all grades? No, only those that were invited for the STEM Fair needed to make a poster board. What is the criteria for getting invited to the STEM Fair this year? There are a number of factors. They chose the best from each grade. There is a rubric. The highest scoring projects Will we have the opportunity to see the STEM projects and learn top prizes What is the criteria to determine if a child qualifies for TAG? There is an OLSAT test that students take in first grade and if they score in the 80th percentile, they would be identified for additional evaluation and screening done by the teacher in accordance with PGCPS standards. What was the impact of Summer Academy? The Summer Academy students were invited with specific focus areas identified and the school is tracking/ measuring against those areas.
