Revisions (changes to ideas, content, clarity, or organization):

- 1. "something like Instagram or TikTok" \rightarrow "platforms like Instagram or TikTok"
 - Clarifies the type of accounts and makes the statement more precise.
- 2. "Some people say its good because you can stay in touch with freinds and see whats happening in the world" → "Some people believe it is beneficial because it allows you to stay in touch with friends and keep up with current events"
 - Strengthens academic tone ("believe it is beneficial")
 - Rewords for clarity and professionalism
 - "Keep up with current events" is more precise than "see what's happening in the world"
- 3. "but other people say its bad because it can make you feel sad or left out when you see other peoples posts" → "However, others argue that it can have negative effects, such as making you feel sad or left out when viewing other people's posts"
 - Adds contrastive transition ("However")
 - Makes tone more formal and precise ("argue" instead of "say," "negative effects" instead of "bad")
- 4. "I think sometimes it can be fun but also distracting when you should be doing homework or talking to your family" → "In my opinion, social media can be enjoyable at times but also distracting when you should be doing homework or spending time with your family"
 - Makes the opinion more formal ("In my opinion")
 - Improves clarity and flow ("spending time with your family" vs "talking to your family")
- 5. "Some people spend hours scrolling and it can affect there sleep and there mood"

 → "Many people spend hours scrolling, which can affect their sleep and mood"
 - Refines phrasing and sentence structure
 - Corrects "there" → "their" (editing, see below)
 - Clarifies cause-and-effect with "which can affect"
- 6. "Overall, social media has both pros and cons" \rightarrow "Overall, social media has both advantages and disadvantages"
 - Formalizes language ("advantages and disadvantages" vs "pros and cons")

Edits (grammar, spelling, punctuation, word choice, minor corrections):

- 1. "nowdays" \rightarrow "nowadays"
 - Corrected spelling
- 2. "its" \rightarrow "it is" or "it's" depending on context
 - Fixed grammar
- 3. "freinds" \rightarrow "friends"
 - Corrected spelling
- 4. "whats" \rightarrow "what's"
 - Fixed contraction/apostrophe
- 5. "other peoples posts" \rightarrow "other people's posts"
 - Corrected possessive apostrophe
- 6. "there sleep and there mood" \rightarrow "their sleep and mood"
 - Corrected grammar
- 7. Added commas and refined punctuation
 - o Example: "Social media is very popular nowadays, and almost everyone..."

REMEMBER:

- **Revising**: Improved clarity, tone, organization, word choice, and formality.
- Editing: Corrected spelling, grammar, punctuation, and minor word errors.
