
# **Zidoo Boot Wizard**

Zidoo RTD1619DR models have included HDR10+ and Dolby Vision VS10 engine, settings are more complex than former models. So that a new boot wizard is available, let's see what the new Boot Wizard looks like.


### 1. Select Language

When the first time to turn on Zidoo media players, we will see the page below to select language initially. Choose language according to your preference by UP and DOWN keys on remote control.



### 2. Screen Zoom

Press UP and DOWN keys on the remote control to adjust the display area.




# 3. Time Zone Setting

### 4. Network Connection




# 5. Select Output Mode


### **5.1 The Wizard Mode**

5.1.2 Connect respective options according to your device connections.











## **5.2 Expert Mode**

The expert mode is suitable for users who are very familiar with Zidoo media players.




It is recommended to set resolution to "AUTO", or set to the highest resolution that the display device can support.




#### **HDR** mode

LLDV TV: It is recommended to choose "AUTO" or "Dolby Vision Low Latency(LLDV,YUV422,12 Bit)".




HDR TV: It is recommended to choose "AUTO" or "Dolby Vision VS10 engine (for HDR)".




SDR TV: It is recommended to choose "AUTO" or "Dolby Vision VS10 engine (for SDR, HDR, DV)".

the display device can choose the VS10 engine directly, and the VS10 engine can convert HDR to SDR, which will help enjoy good image quality near HDR.




After selecting to switch frame rate and resolution, the media player will output with films' original frame rate and resolution if it is supported by a display device.




### Audio output


Choose HDMI audio output according to device connections. When the amplifier and soundbar support multi channel decoding, please choose "RAW". If not, then choose "LPCM 2 Channel".



SPDIF audio setting is the same principle as HDMI audio setting.




SPDIF output supports up to 5.1 only. It is needed to turn on "Downmix HD audio output" for 7.1, or there might be no sound output.



# **6.The Key Definition**


Number keys, subtitle key, audio key, up and down keys, page turning keys can be set according to your preference, so that set can be done by one key easily when playing movies.




