WHAT IS LIONS INTERNATIONAL?

The Hurley Lions Club awards four scholarships of \$1,000 to four (4) applicants who meet the basic requirements and who then attain the highest scores based upon a merit point system of your community and school activities.

BASIC REQUIREMENTS: Applicant Must:

- 1. Be a graduating student in the Kingston or Onteora School Districts (see eligibility above) (or home or private schooled).
- 2. Have a current 'B' average or better.
- 3. Have written acceptance from a post-high school educational institution.

These basic requirements may be waived only if there is no other student who meets all or at least a portion of these requirements. (For example, if there are no applicants who have 'B' averages or higher, then the requirement may be waived by the Hurley Lions Club Scholarship Committee.) If there are no applicants who meet the basic requirements, then the committee may elect to proceed solely upon the merit points.

Points will be determined by the committee. Points indicated on the form are examples and for information only. Check all applicable items and provide a separate list detailing each activity (years involved). Be sure to include any other activities in which you have participated if not listed here. Give dates when appropriate on all listed items.
