



Excellent Teacher Award

Excellence awards of \$500 are available to recognize extraordinary Franklin teachers and professional staff. The funds can be used by the teacher to enhance their work with students--from continuing education opportunities to classroom supplies. One \$500 award will be given to a teacher at each of Franklin's seven schools. ***Any student, parent, peer, or community member can make nominations.***

Nomination Deadline: July 31, 2018

Nomination Requirements and Funding Rules:

- Nominee must be a teacher or professional staff member of Franklin Public Schools
- Nominee may not have already been recognized with this award within the past calendar year
- Awards must be used within one calendar year. They can be applied to participation in high-quality continuing education and/or professional development opportunities, such as seminars, workshops, or courses. (to be done outside of the school year)
- Nominees will be evaluated on their:
 - Dedication to the students of Franklin
 - Extraordinary commitment to inspire students to reach their goals
 - Likelihood that awards will lead to enhanced teaching practices in the classroom
 - Demonstrated leadership abilities and impact on their peers
