Kathy Dryden made a motion to approve annual meeting minutes from 2021. Tom Jenkins 2nd motion and the motion passed unanimously.

Reports:

Kathy Dryden, President, reviewed a list of the Boards actions over the past year, which included:

New Lido website which uses Clubspot for regatta registrations. The new website also has measurement certs. There is also a new Lido swag store on the website. We also have an emergency document that includes a list of all accounts and how to access them.

Earl Thomas, Vice President: reported on the work he did for the Class Championships, including trophies. He discussed the bid for 2023's Class Championship - from the Oregon fleets - Eugene Yacht Club and Willamette Sailing Club. Proposed dates of July 27-30, 2023 at the Fernridge reservoir. Bid for 2024 Class Championships is from ABYC with tentative dates of August 1-4, 2024.
