# 8TH GRADE CLASSROOM MATERIALS

This is a list of supplies students will use throughout the school year. Students should have these materials on the first day of school, and each should be clearly marked with their name (first and last) and locker number. **All students will receive a homework planner from the school, which is the only planner needed.**

## Materials Students Need

- Binders
  - 1 - 1-inch binder for health
  - 3 - 1.5-inch binders with built in pockets (Math, Science and Foundations)
  - Foreign Language: 1.5-inch binder with built in pockets (Chinese, Spanish, Latin), 2-inch binder (Mythos), 3-inch binder (French)
- Dividers
  - 8 sets of dividers for binders (5-tabs/set)
- Writing Utensils
  - Plenty of #2 pencils, traditional or mechanical, and erasers
  - Plenty of blue and black ink pens, one red
  - 2-3 highlighters
  - 1 pack of 5 (or more) black dry erase markers (**for foreign language**)
  - 1 multicolor pack of 12 (or more) colored pencils
  - 1 multicolor pack of markers - Crayola classic color pack of 10 is ideal (**for Chinese**)
- Math Supplies
  - Graphing calculator (TI 83 Plus, TI 84, or TI 84 Plus are recommended models by Texas Instruments\*)
  - 1 pack loose-leaf graph paper
  - Protractor and compass (**Geometry only**)
- Misc.
  - Loose-leaf, lined notebook paper for each binder
  - Pencil case/bag – equipped with writing and measuring tools for each class
  - 3”x 5” index cards (**for foreign language; it’s always good to have extras!**)
  - White-out tape
  - 12-inch ruler, displaying both centimeters and inches (**for Math and Science**)
  - Scissors

- Headset with microphone - or a laptop with built-in microphone for online recording **(for Chinese only)**

### **Additional Information**
