A Note about Immunizations from the Health Office

Colorado law requires students who attend a public, private, or parochial kindergarten - 12th grade school to be vaccinated against many diseases vaccines can prevent, unless a certificate of exemption is filed. For more information, visit the Colorado Department of Public Health and Environment required vaccines web page.

Your student must be vaccinated against or have an exemption on file for:

- Diphtheria, tetanus and pertussis (DTaP, DTP, Tdap)
- Hepatitis B (HepB)
- Measles, mumps and rubella (MMR)
- Polio (IPV)
- Varicella (chickenpox)

Colorado follows recommendations set by the Advisory Committee on Immunization Practices.

- Students entering kindergarten must receive their final doses of DTaP, IPV, MMR and varicella.
- Students entering 6th grade must receive one dose of Tdap vaccine, even if they are under 11 vears of age.
- o All recommendations are on the <u>Centers for Disease Control vaccine schedule web page.</u>

Vaccines are recommended for hepatitis A, influenza, meningococcal disease and human papillomavirus, but are not required.

You may request these kinds of exemptions from immunizations:

- Medical Exemption: good forever while child is enrolled at PSD
- **Non-medical Exemption:** must be renewed each year. That can be done by going to the Colorado Department of Public Health and Environment site https://cdphe.colorado.gov/vaccine-exemptions

Please make sure that you have completed the requirements for immunization or exemption as soon as

possible and no later than October 31. If you have questions regarding these requirements or wish to email your immunization record, please send those to our health technician, Kris Kissel (kkissel@psdschools.org).
