Payment Options

In person: Pay by cash, check, or money order to the Business Office located at the Anderson Center or drop in the locked black mailbox located next to the ATM in the BC.

Online through MyBethel: MyBethel>CAS Student tab>Click "Make a Payment". This will direct you to the Touchnet/Bill Pay site. Click "Deposits" on the top toolbar> select term "CAS Fall 2026" (or "CAS Summer 2026") and click select> select appropriate Course Title/Code then continue with your payment by following the prompts.

-Online by Electronic Check with no fee: Authorize a one-time payment of automatic withdrawal from your checking or savings account.

-Online by credit card: VISA, Mastercard, American Express, or Discover.

NOTE: Credit card payments have an additional processing fee charged by PayPath (processing service).

Using Loans: If you're using loans to pay for your January course, the program fee will be charged to your account in January. Please confirm with the study abroad office and the Office of Financial Aid if you are using loans.

Other Notices

Withdrawing from a Course: Students must fill out and submit the "[Faculty-Led Course Withdrawal](#)" [Google Form](#) to officially notify the Office of International and Off-Campus Programs of their intent to withdraw from a course.

(Even if you have not yet made any payments, course instructors may have already begun making payments on your behalf to reserve airfare, room, board, etc., so you must notify the study abroad office ASAP of your withdrawal in order to avoid further unrecoverable charges.) Please also review the [Financial Commitment Policy and Agreement](#) before withdrawing.

December Graduates and Part-Time Spring Students: January Session tuition is based on the number of credits enrolled for Spring Semester (January Session + Spring Session). Please Note: Registration for less than 12 credits (0-11 credits) in Spring Semester will result in being charged for January tuition in addition to your study abroad course cost.
