Municipality of San Juan was selected as a model building area for YBP and thru this meeting, Dir. Marcelo Nicomedes J. Castillo and DSWD staff virtually congratulated San Juan for its achievements under the implementation of YBP.

4. Drug Test of LGU Employees

The Human Resource and Management Office of LGU San Juan, as part of MADAC, conducted an authorized drug testing for LGU employees last February 23, 2022. The tested employees came from the departments: MENRO, MDRRMO and MEO. Results of the conducted drug testing were kept confidential and was given proper intervention by MADAC through the Chief Executive, Hon. Ildebrando D. Salud and HRMO, Mrs. Teresita Illustrado.



5. YBP Orientation to Pilot Barangays: Talahiban 2.0

A total of 95 participants attended the orientation of Yakap Bayan Program in Brgy. Talahiban 2.0, San Juan, Batangas, one of the pilot areas of YBP model building in San Juan. Participants were composed of RPWUDs, BADAC Members, Community Volunteers (4Ps), BJMP Officers and facilitators from MADAC.



6. YBP Orientation to Pilot Barangays: Laiya Aplaya

A total of 43 participants attended the orientation of Yakap Bayan Program in Brgy. Laiya Aplaya, San Juan, Batangas, one of the pilot areas of YBP model building in San Juan. Participants were composed of RPWUDs, BADAC Members, Community Volunteers (4Ps), Academe and facilitators from MADAC.



7. Meat Processing at Talahiban 2.0 (YBP Livelihood for RPWUDs)

RPWUDs from Brgy. Talahiban 2.0 together with their wives started their livelihood activity, Meat Processing last March 9, 2022. They processed tocino and tapa both 10 kilos each and marketed their products at their barangay.



8. Meat Processing at Laiya Aplaya (YBP Livelihood for RPWUDs)

RPWUDs from Brgy. Laiya Aplaya started their livelihood activity, Meat Processing last February 1, 2022 and March 9, 2022. They processed 10 kilos of tocino per session and marketed their products at their barangay.



9. Swine Raising at Escribano (YBP Livelihood for RPWUDs)

RPWUDs from Brgy. Escribano started their livelihood activity, Swine Raising last March 18, 2022. They invested into 10 heads of swine. The swine are being managed by the 16 RPWUDs of Escribano.



10. Launching of KKDK at BJMP (Katatagan, Kalusugan at Damayan ng Komunidad)

In support to the recovery journey of PWUDs of San Juan, Batangas, San Juan MADAC Focal Person, Mr. Arnold Enriquez, MLGOO, Ms. Christie Arcega and YBP staff participated in BJMP's launching of Katatagan, Kalusugan at Damayan ng Komunidad or KKDK at San Juan BJMP's facility last March 10, 2022. This is a program under CBRD which offers drug recovery skills, life skills and family sessions as endorsed by the Inter-Agency Committee on Anti-Illegal Drugs to the DDB as a model for LGUs.



11. Training on Multi-Dimensional Reintegration Tool & YBP Information System

MDT of San Juan attended 3 days training last April 6 – 8, 2022 at Kabayan Beach Resort, Brgy. Laiya Aplaya, San Juan, Batangas.



12. Training on YB Aftercare Modules

MDT of San Juan attended 4 days training last May 17 - 20, 2022 at Leonida's Exclusive Resort, Brgy. Banga, Talisay, Batangas.



13. Baselineing

MDT conducted interview for Multi-Dimensional Reintegration Tool with RPWUDs and their families and community during the month of May 2022. Baselineing was conducted at the pilot barangays (barangay hall and house to house)

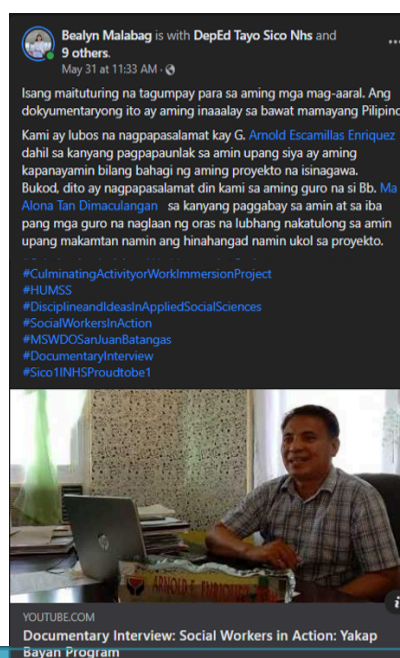
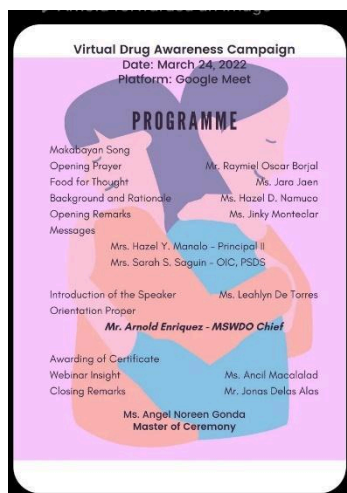


14. Meeting with RPWUDs

18. Aftercare Sessions to RPWUDs (Laiya Aplaya and Talahiban 2.0)

Conducted simultaneously to 2 pilot barangays. Sessions were conducted last June 9 and 10 and will progress until July 1, 2022. Two modules are being conducted per day and the facilitators are the Multi-Disciplinary Team of San Juan, Batangas.



19. Multi-Disciplinary Team Meeting

DSWD Field Office Staff, Ms. Rosalyn Cepillo facilitated the 1st Yakap Bayan Program MDT Meeting last June 8, 2022. Present virtually during the meeting were STB of DSWD Central Office. The MDT members from PNP, BJMP, MSWDO, RHU, HRMO, MAO, MENRO and BADAC attended the meeting. Agenda during the meeting were: Status of YBP Program implementation in San Juan, Batangas, Presentation of Calendar of Activities for CY 2022 and other matters concerning the program implementation.



20. Capacitation of BADAC on Barangay Dug Clearing Program

PDEA Batangas conducted 1 day seminar for BADAC composed of BADAC Chairman, Secretary and Peace and Order Committee Head of 42 barangays in San Juan, Batangas last June 20, 2022 held at San Juan Evacuation Center, Brgy. Buhaynasapa, San Juan, Batangas. Agent Jennifer Quintana discussed most of the topics related to campaign against illegal drugs and the process of Barangay Dug Clearing Program. She informed also the group about the result of 2021 revalidation of all barangays whereas 35 out of 42 barangays remained drug-free.



21. Care for Carers Session of MDT San Juan

Conducted last June 21, 2022 at ABC Session Hall. The activity was facilitated by HRMO Staff, Buenafe Rondero and Ms. Rosalyn Cepillo of DSWD Regional Office Staff. Discussions about overview of YBP Carers Session, common stressors faced by social service frontline workers and Stress Management and self-care were presented during morning session. Wellness activities were conducted on the afternoon session.
