

## How To Set Up Your Fundraising Page to Support the Agahozo-Shalom Youth Village

- 1. The Columbia/Barnard fundraising page can be found at fundraise.asyv.org/columbia2026.
- 2. To set up a personal fundraising page as part of the group page, click "Become a Fundraiser." You will be prompted to create a <u>classy.org</u> login in order to access your fundraising portal.
- 3. Next, you will be prompted to set a personal fundraising goal, a headline, and an optional short URL for the page. You can further personalize your page by clicking "manage" in the top navigation. Add a photo of yourself and share why supporting ASYV is personal to you.
  - \*Note: If you would prefer to share the main Columbia/Barnard fundraising page, rather than your personal page, donors will still have the option to credit their gift to you when making their donation (see below).

- 4. You can use your fundraising portal to review your donations and quickly thank your supporters. A personalized email or handwritten note also goes a long way!
- 5. Tips for successful fundraising:
  - o Be sure to customize your page and make it personal
  - Make a 'kickoff' gift (of any size!) to demonstrate your investment
  - Start by sharing the page with your inner-circle before sharing it more widely
  - o Follow up
  - Share your progress
  - Thank your supporters
  - Increase your goal if you surpass it this can be done in the Classy portal or by reaching out to Jill Elias at Jill@asyv.org

- 7. If any of your supporters wish to make a gift by check, wire, or Venmo (more info here), ASYV can add these donations to your page. They should be sure to include a note with their gift stating that the donation is intended to support your Columbia/Barnard fundraising page (be sure that they note Columbia/Barnard and your name).
