Donald R. Zwickey, 54, formerly of Oshkosh, died Monday in Milwaukee.

He was born here on Oct. 22, 1922, son of Merlyn and Bonita Zwickey, and was married to Doris Mae Keeshan of Oshkosh on Aug. 16, 1948.

Mr. Zwickey attended Wisconsin State Teachers College, and received a degree in business administration from University of Wisconsin-Madison. He had been employed in the Department of Public Works, Milwaukee, and was in a supervisory position at the time of his death. He served three years in the Navy during World War II.
