COLLEGE and SCHOLARSHIP NOTES

- 1. You should be finishing up your **admission applications** to your top college choices. You should apply to at least three: your **Target, Reach, and Safety** schools. If not, do so ASAP. Applying is not complicated and takes just a few minutes! Go to the account you created at <u>parchment.com</u> to **send transcripts** to colleges.
- 2. Use your 2020 income information to complete the **2022-23 FAFSA** at <u>fafsa.gov</u>. Do this ASAP so your financial aid is established at your school. This is required for <u>ALL SENIORS</u> in order to graduate! Remember to have your parent create an FSA ID at least 3 days prior. Also, make sure that you remember your FSA ID.
 - a. Northwest Shoals FAFSA Night on November 9th from 4:00 pm- 7:00 pm located in Building 127 Muscle Shoals Campus
 - b. ELHS will have another Parent FAFSA Night in December.
- 3. Remember to fill out all academic, leadership, foundational, and departmental **scholarships** on time (examples: USA Computing, Auburn Poultry Science, Auburn Chemical Engineering, UNA Chemistry and Industrial Hygiene. Also a LONG list of Foundation/endowed scholarships at UNA). These are found on each college's website. Visit your college website and click on financial aid or scholarships. Pay attention to upcoming December deadlines (UAB, UAH, USA, Auburn).
- 4. Nov 5th was the deadline to register for the Dec 11 ACT without a late fee! You can still register before Nov 19th. An ACT Fee Waiver covers the registration and late fees for either the full ACT with writing or the full ACT (no writing). - 5. Consider HONORS programs at your college. Smaller classes, advanced scheduling, research, mentoring, and traveling opportunities.
- 6. U of AL Advantage Scholarship pays full tuition for any student who receives a full pell grant. Must be admitted unconditionally by Jan 15. https://scholarships.ua.edu/aladvantage/
- 7. Are you a child of a Veteran? Find out about GI Bill and Veteran's Education benefits! Applications may be obtained at any Alabama Dpt. of Veterans Affairs Office. Info at https://www.military.com/education/gi-bill

- 8. You will receive Balfour packets (to order cap/gown and other graduation supplies) on Nov 17 at 1:30pm. Mike Mills will return to ELHS on Dec 1 to pick up orders. If you are not ready to turn in your order by then, you can mail your order to Balfour. Let Mrs. Sizemore know before December 1 if you need help with the purchase of your cap and gown. The senior package includes cap/ gown, tassel, diploma and diploma cover, and totals @ \$90.
- 9. Guys: When you turn 18, register for the Selective Service at www.sss.gov. It's the law, and keeps you eligible for loans, grants, and work studies.
- 10. All seniors must pass the Civics Exam, taken with your Government class (Mr. Bennett). If you take Government through LCSS (Mr. Hill), you will take it there with him.
