TV HDMI Inputs

HDMI2 = In-Room PC / Video Conferencing HDMI1 = HDMI direct cable for laptop plugins

Step 1: Turn on TV



Press the Power button on the left side of the TV to turn it on.

Step 2: Choose the Desired Input Device

You can toggle through all of the Sharp TV Input devices by pressing the Input Button on the left side of the screen until the correct HDMI input is selected.

HDMI1 is for laptop connections & HDMI2 is for the in-room NUC PC.



Option A: In-Room PC (HDMI2) & Video Conferencing

To use the In-Room PC, change the input on the TV to use HDMI2 using the Input button on the left side of the TV

There is a Logitech wireless keyboard+trackpad. (Make sure the power switch is turned on)

The in-room PC is equipped with a webcam for easy video conferencing using Skype or Zoom. Icons for the applications are ready to go on the desktop.





Option B: Direct HDMI cable from back of TV to Laptop (HDMI1)

To use a Laptop with the HDMI cable, make sure the Sharp TV Input is set to HDMI1 using the Input button on the left side of the TV.

Note: HDMI cables carry both audio & video. You can use the volume Up or Down on the left side of the TV and on your PC/Mac laptop to control.

If your laptop does not have an HDMI port, connect the appropriate adapter to the HDMI cable and then connect the adapter to your laptop (Mini DisplayPort or USB Type C).



Note: Other faculty/staff often leave dongles connected to the HDMI cables, be sure to remove/attach the adapters as needed to make sure that you are not inadvertently plugging a disconnected adapter into your laptop.

Note: You may have to reboot your laptop in order for it to sync to the TV input

Problems with Audio?


If audio doesn't play over the speakers in this room, check your computer's audio settings. Output should be set to: "Sharp TV."

Windows 10 PC

At the bottom right of the screen, right click the sound icon.



Then select the



From the Sound settings panel, use the drop down menu to choose the LG TV output device.

Choose your output device

SHARP HDMI (Intel(R) Display Audio)

You may use the Volume slider to raise/lower the volume as desired.

Apple Mac

Navigate to the Apple > System Preferences and choose Sound.



On the Sound preferences panel, click Output tab and then choose the LG TV as the output device.
