Code of Practice For Parents And Guardians

As the parent or guardian of a member of the Priory Tennis Club, you are expected to abide by the following code of practice.

- Encourage your child to learn the rules of tennis and play with them.
- Discourage unfair play and arguing with officials.
- Help your child to recognise good performance, not just results.
- Never force your child to take part in sport.
- Set a good example by recognising fair play and applauding the good performances of all.
- Never punish or belittle a child for losing or making mistakes.
- Publicly accept judgements made by officials.
- Support your child's involvement and help them to enjoy the sport.
- Use correct and proper language at all times.
- Allow your child to play in the Mini Tennis colour league that is appropriate to them. This will ensure that they enjoy playing the game, develop their skills and gain confidence.
- Purchase balls and rackets that match the stage that your child is at.
- Be patient, steady progression is unusual in children, peaks and plateaus are common.
- Your first question following any match, should be "did you enjoy it?" not "did you win?"
- At no stage should you communicate with your child or interfere with the on court helpers or officials during a match. Just enjoy the game and let the officials take care of the rules!

Code of Conduct For Juniors

As a junior member of Priory Tennis Club, you are expected to abide by the following code of practice.

- All members must play within the rules and respect officials and their decisions.
- All members must respect the rights, dignity and worth of all participants regardless of age, gender, race, ability, cultural background, religious beliefs, or sexual identity.
- Members should keep to agreed timings for training and competitions or inform their coach or team manager if they are going to be late.
- Members must wear suitable kit for training and match sessions as agreed with the coach.
- Junior members must recognise that smoking is not permitted on club premises or whilst representing the club at competitions.

Junior members are not permitted to consume alcohol or drugs of any type on the club premises or whilst representing the club.
