- In the show there was mention of an Oregon 300 no longer working. I still have my Colorado 300, my first GPS that supported paperless Geocaching. In 2019 when the GPS week number was reset, the Colorados date and time were no

longer correct, although it did show the location. Newer GPS receivers either made provisions for the rollover or Garmin pushed out a patch. I thought support was completely over for this one, but I continued to occasionally connect the 300 to the computer and check for updates using Garmin Express. Eventually Garmin pushed out a patch for this older receiver, and once again its working with the correct date and time.


