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PROFESSIONAL SUMMARY

Student-centered educator with 30+ years of experience supporting homeschool, neurodivergent, and learning-challenged students. I design learning experiences that fit how each student thinks and feels, with a focus on self-directed education, customized ELA curricula, and trauma-informed environments that center student autonomy. I'm especially drawn to students who have been considered "difficult" or "behind," and I help them rebuild a sense of safety and competence around learning.

AUGUST 2017 – PRESENT

- Design and facilitate long-term, individualized learning plans for English language learners, neurodivergent students, and students with learning disabilities. I prioritize emotional safety and regulation as foundations for academic and personal growth.
- Develop flexible ELA and integrated projects that shift as students' interests change. Instead of tests, I use work samples, written reflections, and conversations so students can see and talk about their own growth.
- I created "The ELA Alcove," a suite of English Language Arts scaffolds and tools to support differentiated reading and writing instruction.
- Work closely with families transitioning from traditional school to homeschooling, walking them through deschooling, planning learning together, and showing them how to support choice and collaboration at home.
- Help students who struggled in traditional settings re-engage with learning. Many go from avoiding writing to completing full paragraphs and short essays within their first semester.
- Support English language learners in making rapid progress. Multiple students have tested English Language Proficient after one year. Guided a 10th-grade student with multiple disabilities to improve by three grade levels in one year, and she ultimately graduated from high school with honors.
