

CPS PFC Fundraising Survey 2024

Summary of Results

1. Enhance outdoor space and infrastructure

The most salient issues were upgrading/expanding playground areas and protection from sun/rain when the children are outdoors.

Specifically:

- New/more play equipment and nature play
- Roof cover/shelter for sports and assemblies
- Sports equipment : Permanent footy/soccer goals

2. Upgrades to school hall

Renovation/expansion : Expand double storey to accommodate OSHC upstairs and school assemblies downstairs.

- Large enclosed gym/assembly hall, music room, athletic track

3. Upgrade/expand resources

Tech equipment in general. Specific mentions: New laptops/iPads

- Improved PA system for assembly to enable everyone to hear
- Books: More library books, books that older children can read + more novels in the library / maintenance of library

4. Enhancing access to green space:

- Japanese garden, community garden, vegetable gardens
- Grass and more trees

5. Toilets

Singled out as being an important piece of infrastructure that requires improved maintenance/upgrade and even expansion

- New toilets or toilet upgrade/renovation
- More toilets in general and a toilet facility near the 3/4 and 5/6 building
- Enhance cleanliness of toilets

6. Expand opportunities to engage with Japanese food and culture

- Japanese food education and school lunches
- More Japanese cultural events: Koinobori, hinamatsuri, mochitsuki, Otsukimi

7. Infrastructure/staff resources

- Coffee machine for the teachers staff room
- Improve drainage in the middle of the schoolyard (near the small sandbox)
- Pigeon droppings + something so pigeons don't get into the classroom
- Safer stairs

- Animal sheds for each grade
- To have a school nurse
- To give more help on Japanese tuition to non Japanese students
- Canteen/cafeteria
- Flea market
