- email: studentID@Irstudents.org password: student creates password
- College Search-Create a list based on admission difficulty, location, athletics, majors, etc.
- Build a resume (found in About Me) to be used in college applications.
- My personality Career Inventory matches careers to your personality.
- Add colleges to colleges I am applying to.

# **NCAA**

- If you are an athlete interested in Division I or Division II sports, you must complete the NCAA eligibility form at <a href="https://web3.ncaa.org/ecwr3/">https://web3.ncaa.org/ecwr3/</a> \$100 to register
- After you complete the online form, complete this transcript request form

- Send official SAT or ACT scores electronically from the testing agency to the NCAA.

#### SAT's

- Register online: <u>www.collegeboard.org</u> \$68.00
- A photo of passport quality (face front) is required on the registration ticket. The photo will be downloaded and printed on the admission ticket.
- You must send official SAT scores to colleges you are applying to electronically at www.collegebard.org
- Please allow up to 2 weeks for the SAT scores to arrive at your college.

#### ACT's

- Register online: www.actstudent.org
   \$68 with out writing
   \$25.00 to add writing
- A photo of passport quality (face front) is required on the registration ticket. The photo will be downloaded and printed on the admission ticket.
- You must send official ACT scores to colleges electronically at <a href="https://www.actstudent.org">www.actstudent.org</a>
- Please allow up to 2 weeks for the ACT scores to arrive at your college.

# Rowan College Burlington County & Rowan University CAP classes

- Request a transcript from <u>RCBC to be sent to colleges</u>.
- You can also request an electronic transcript to be sent for a small fee.
- For any language CAP credits from Rowan University, you must log in to your Banner account.

#### **Scholarships**

- Check out the <u>Seneca Scholarship</u> page.
- Check local and national scholarships:
- Common Application: in profile section, check "yes", non-college specific affiliated scholarships
- Fill out transcript request form to send transcripts for scholarships.

## **Financial Aid**

- Complete FAFSA (Free Application for Federal Student Aid) beginning October 1st
- Visit <u>Financial Aid website</u>.
- Create an account and request a password for yourself & parent/guardian
- Check individual state & college deadlines for FAFSA.
- Complete your <u>CSS Profile</u>- specific to the university.
- <u>HESAA</u>- great financial aid resource.

# **College Applications & Transcripts:**

# **How Many Schools Should I Apply to?**

- Reach 1-2, Good Match 2-3, Safe 1-2
- Think about major, location, size, setting (rural/urban/suburban), extracurricular activities, etc.
- Realistic evaluation of each college's admission requirements (grades, standardized test scores, required high school courses).
- Check out: <a href="https://bigfuture.collegeboard.org/college-search">https://bigfuture.collegeboard.org/college-search</a> (Great tool for searching colleges)

#### **Application Types**

- **Early decision** is a contract between you and the college. You can only apply to 1 school early decision. <u>If you are accepted, you MUST attend. This is a legally BINDING contract!</u>
- **Early action** is more flexible. You do not have to commit to the college if you are accepted. You can apply to multiple schools. Non-binding contract. These dates are early, check your colleges for deadlines! Remember you should request your transcript 2 weeks before the deadline.
- Rolling Admission-Applications are evaluated as they are received. Once the college has reached their deadline students are waitlisted or not accepted. Don't delay!
- Regular Decision- Decisions are made once ALL applications have been received by deadline.
- **Priority/VIP**-Sent to you by the college. Sometimes no application fee or shorter notification time.
- Self-Report- <u>Does not</u> need a high school transcript or recommendation letters. You <u>must</u> self-report your grades electronically on the college website. They will only need a final transcript in June if you plan to attend.

# **Teacher Recommendation Letters**

- Add at least 1 school in "colleges I am applying to"
- Ask early and politely. Give at least two weeks' notice.
- Check with college for maximum number of letters of recommendation
- Formally request the letter of recommendation in Naviance after you asked the teacher and they said, "Yes." (Students must add the schools they are applying to prior).
- Complete Teacher and Counselor "Brag Sheet" under My Surveys

- Students will not be permitted to see the letter. You will need to waive your right to see the letter on the common application. Check SCOIR to see when letters are completed.
- Counselors will automatically write a letter. You do not have to ask your counselor to write a letter.

## Ways to Apply

- Online-Visit the college website & apply using the college's online application
- Common Application- www.commonapp.org
  - Fill out once for multiple schools
  - After completing the "education" section of common app., sign the FERPA page and then Match in Naviance found in "colleges I am applying to"
  - o Be careful-Some schools have online supplemental forms as well & additional essays
- Apply with SCOIR- Click on "Start App" in the My Colleges tab
- If using a **Priority or Free application**, supporting documents will not be sent electronically through SCOIR. They will need to be printed and mailed, this may increase wait time at the college's end.

# **The Application & Transcript Process**

- Complete the application online on college website or on Common App website.
  - Submit application and pay fees.
- \*Request a transcript for each individual college via SCOIR\*
- The Counselor will complete and send requested transcripts, school profile, and letters of recommendation electronically. Check SCOIR to make sure your teachers have completed their recommendation letters.

# Mid-Year & Final Transcripts

- We do NOT automatically send mid-year.
- Students must submit a mid-year grade request through Naviance at the end of the 1st semester.
- All students will meet with their counselor for the final college decision.
- Registrar will send the final transcript approximately 2 weeks after graduation.
