Congressman BranofRaisin (R-List Seat) attends the Congressional Swearing in Ceremony and swears in on a Christian Standard Bible:

I do solemnly affirm that I will support and defend the Constitution of the United States against all enemies, foreign and domestic; that I will bear true faith and allegiance to the same; that I will take this obligation freely, without any mental reservation or purpose of evasion, and that I will well and faithfully discharge the duties of the office on which I am about to enter.

Shortly after swearing in, Congressman Bran raisin (R-List) announced his run for Speaker of the House of Representatives. His public statement after announcing his run is as follows:

"Congress is broken and we have not been doing what is needed to deliver and bring home to the American People. They need us to try to reform the government to make their lives better. I would say it is better for the government to do no more, but we need to enact some reforms before we get to that point. After internal discussions in the GOP, the likely nominee for Speaker of the House is a good man, but not the man we need to stand up to fight for what is needed. There must be more conservative representation for the millions of conservatives across this country. I have declared my intentions in intra party circles, but if we fail to win the nomination there, we will get enough support to force the likely speaker on the house floor to make concessions. We are fine with political differences and compromise, but compromise must be both ways."

The congressman is open and willing to negotiate, but he wants to see how the initial vote on the house floor goes before making final negotiations with any leadership to ensure some of what he and his supporters want as concessions. Look out for future press releases from Congressman BranofRaisin
