## Spring FlyingJam 2025 *Terms & Conditions*

- Organizers of the Spring FlyingJam 2025 (referred to as the *competition*) are Faculty of Mathematics and Physics, Charles University and Game Developers Session (referred to as *organizers*). All participants of the competitions are referred to as *entrants*.
- 2. The **competition is open to all residents of the European Union** that are aged 16 years or over.
- 3. There is no entry fee and no purchase necessary to enter this competition.
- 4. By entering this competition, an entrant is indicating his/her/their agreement to be bound by these terms and conditions.
- 5. You can enter the competition either as an individual or as a member of the team (we refer to an individual or a team as a *contestant*).
- 6. In order to enter the competition, you are required to have an itch.io account (free registration) and sign up with that account to Spring FlyingJam 2025 through itch.io webpage.
- 7. One team can consist of up-to four entrants at maximum.
- 8. A team consisting of five and more entrants are exempt from the competition.
- 9. One contestant may submit only one entry into the competition.
- 10. Multiple entries from the same contestant (solo developer or a team) will be all disqualified from the competition.
- 11. Closing date for submitting the entry to the competition is 30.3.2025 6:00PM (CEST). After this date, no further entries to the competition will be permitted.
- 12. No responsibility can be accepted for entries not received for whatever reason.
- 13. There are two set of prizes contestants may win: A) Spring FlyingJam 2025 Prize;B) People's Award of Spring FlyingJam 2025.
- 14. Entries will be judged by all the contestants (People's Award of Spring FlyingJam 2025) as well as a panel of judges (Spring FlyingJam 2025 Prize).
- 15. The competition **might be** prize-awarded.
- 16. Prizes will be sent to / can be claimed by EU located contestants only.
- 17. The prize is as stated and no cash or other alternatives will be offered. The prizes are not transferable. Prizes are subject to availability and we reserve the right to substitute any prize with another of equivalent value without giving notice.
- 18. Organizers are not responsible for inaccurate prize details supplied to any contestant and any entrant by any third party connected with this competition.
- 19. Prizes will be sent to contestants either via post or email (according to the nature of the prize).
- 20. Claiming the prize is not enforceable by law.
- 21. Entrants agree that photos, video, or other media recordings may be taken during the event. These materials may be used by the organizers for promotional purposes, including but not limited to social media, websites, and future event materials. If you do not wish to be photographed, please inform the event staff upon arrival.

- 22. Entrants grant all organizers full rights to use images and/or video resulting from their work (the games and their itch.io page), and any reproductions or adaptations of the images and/or video for fundraising, publicity or other purposes to help achieve the organizers' aims. This might include (but is not limited to), the right to use them in their printed and online publicity, social media, press releases and funding applications.
- 23. Entrants grant all organizers the right to download, store, reproduce and exhibit all games created for the competition including their incorporation in larger bodies or software.
- 24. This competition is in no way sponsored, endorsed or administered by, or associated with Facebook, Twitter or any other Social Network. You are providing your information to organizers and not to any other party (except itch.io where the online site is organized).
- 25. Organizers shall have the right, at its sole discretion and at any time, to change or modify these terms and conditions, such change(s) shall be effective immediately upon announcement before, during or after the competition takes place.
- 26. The organizers' decision in respect of all matters to do with the competition will be final and no correspondence will be entered into.
- 27. Organizers also reserve the right to cancel the competition if circumstances arise outside of its control.
- 28. Organizers reserve the right to cancel or amend the competition and these terms and conditions without notice in the event of a catastrophe, war, civil or military disturbance, act of God or any actual or anticipated breach of any applicable law or regulation or any other event outside of the organizers' control. Any changes to the competition will be notified to entrants as soon as possible by organizers.
