The goals of this class are as follows:

- Improve paragraph writing skills by focusing on organization, structure, and content.
- Incorporate reading into our writing to strengthen claims by properly selecting and citing text evidence.
- Support students with work in their English classes.
- Build confidence in our writing to help us be successful in all classes.
- → Each student will have a writing notebook and folder that they must bring to class each day. I will provide this. Students will need a charged Chromebook and 2 sharpened pencils. Please be in your seat, ready to learn by the time the bell rings each day!
- → Students will be given a citizenship grade which will account for 15% of their grade. They will earn points in this area by keeping up, participating, giving full effort, being respectful, and being prepared for class.
- → The grade distribution is as follows:
 - 15% Citizenship
 - 50% Assessments
 - ◆ 35% Classwork
- → No homework will be given for this class. Students should use that extra time to do their English work, IXL, or read their book for their English class.

*Students will take a pre-test, midterm, and post-test in which they write a paragraph to show growth and improvement. Mrs. Hansen will conference with English teachers and counselors to determine the best elective for students next semester.

 - Come in at lunch or do work at home if you are behind.
