- Goals:
 - Focus on building community with Hamilton families and neighbors
 - Focus on creating Fundraising events that incorporate community building and making money. Goal for fundraising this year: \$5,000
 - Focus on building more staff appreciation opportunities throughout the school year

School Leadership Report and Feedback/Q&A (10 - 15 minutes)

- Dimarly Suarez provided updates
 - Talent show May 13th
 - o DC trip planned for 8th graders of 22-23 school year
 - March 24th meeting
 - Sparks field trips continuing: Metro State University this Friday
 - Denver Children's Choir coming to Hamilton next year for a before school program
 - Beautification projects planned Fix the Art Room Days 10-2pm (March 19th, March 26th, April 2nd); Drama will also be working on the stage those days
 - New exterior banners and welcome mats
 - Student murals after Spring Break
- Fernanda Dillon provided some updates

- Families/visitors pick-ups will remain the same at door (pickup outside); if there
 is an appointment, can be virtual or in-person
 - Events can be in person; PTSA meetings and events could resume in person if preferred
- In contact with FACE to understand parent classes that could be offered, help bring families into the building; Fe will share with PTSA to determine classes
- Starting in advisory this week, students will be watching Youtube lessons (e.g., Dealing with Digital Drama, Celebrating Diversity) and discussing in class; videos will be shared in newsletter so families can watch together as well
- DPS Multicultural team of 6 coaches will start working with Hamilton for 8 weeks to observe classes, assist/train staff and improve systems
 - No cost to Hamilton, these coaches are DPS Central Office employees
 - Hamilton has a high student need and ready to receive the support
- Implementing procedures to improve attendance; rate has improved from 77% in January to 87% now

School Funding Requests: (10 Min.)

- Grade Level Incentives
 - Dimarly presented the request: attendance, behavioral, grades are the top priorities areas for school right now
 - For each month rest of year, will focus on one of the priorities to provide an incentive for a winning grade level (e.g., highest attendance/ most improved attendance grade level gets hot cocoa party)
 - School is creating posters throughout school to build excitement
 - Request of \$255 for food items; may need volunteers for May event
 - Suggestion of contacting Regal for popcorn donations
 - Approved by vote: 8 members
- School Dance
 - Student request Anna provided an overview of the request form and options for PTSA to discuss/approve (first student funding request!)
 - School dance on March 25th to celebrate students being back together
 - Initial request for \$1,600
 - Funding would cover pizza, decorations, drinks, cookies
 - School would fund maintenance, security staff
 - Students also working on donations
 - Concern that date may need to be pushed to April to allow more time for planning
 - Anna proposed approving funding up to \$800
 - Harmony can work with the students on options to purchase and estimate costs; Dimarly can help with decoration suggestions
 - Check back to a prior meeting where there was a parent who DJs
 - Approved by vote of \$800: 8 members
