**Re:** Student Enrollment and Transfer Guidelines during Standardized Testing

During the dates shown below, student enrollment and transfers should be managed as indicated.

<b><u>Assessment Type</u></b>	<b><u>Date of Assessment</u></b>	<b><u>Grade Levels Involved</u></b>
• PSSA Window	April 20 - May 1, 2026	Grades 3 - 8
• Spring Keystone Testing	May 11 - 22, 2026	Grades 7 - 11

<b><u>Enrollment Type</u></b>	<b><u>Appropriate Action</u></b>
• New enrollment of students from a non-district school (e.g., charter, parochial, private)	Enroll without delay
• Transfer for students who relocate to another primary residence	Enroll without delay
• Students who experience a change in parental custody and relocate to another primary residence	Enroll without delay
• Students returning from hospitalization or placement programs (e.g., adjudicated youth, Pennypack House and Philadelphia Juvenile Justice Service Center )	Enroll without delay
• Students experiencing homelessness (McKinney-Vento)	Enroll without delay
• Administrative transfers	Placements will only occur on an as-needed basis
• Students who are under DHS care	Enroll without delay; questions should be referred to the Office of Student Rights and Responsibilities
• Students who receive disciplinary action	All cases will be evaluated by the Office of Student Rights and Responsibilities
