Laura's Updates:

- Board positions:

- Sunshine Committee:

 - Comment from Kristen: Would be good to check to make sure that HR wouldn't have an issue; it has to be very fair and equal. Meghan: Wouldn't be gifts; it would just be decorations and breakfast for anyone for that month of birthdays. Janie: Sunshine committees are pretty standard for schools and hasn't seen an issue. Meghan: We could standardize or create some guidelines around types of celebrations. Kevin: There may be rules around gifts from a tax perspective. Sunshine committee might be a gray area. Kristen: Could it be incorporated into Teacher Appreciation budget line? Alex: Can you give funds for the Sunshine committee, and allow the committee to choose what to do with it?
 - Laura & Meghan will work on guidelines.
 - Any objections to covering on-campus showers? No objections at this time. One shower has happened, one hasn't.
 - Suggestion is to vote to increase teacher appreciation funds by \$300.

Kevin's Updates / Budget

- Current budget:
 - o Allocated accounts: Decided last call to clear those out except some.

- Auction: Coming in at a net of \$36k
- o For the year: About \$92k of income, not including Bubble Run
- Expenses: About \$15k (net)
 - Meghan will have a few additional expenses
- Laura: Did Betterworld come out?
- Smore: Meghan has a receipt for this
- Planning:
 - Met recently; filled in staples based on last 2 years' numbers for projections. Sam philosophy: Under-estimate income, over-estimate expenditures.
 - o Column J shows change to previous year
 - o Income:
 - Donations: + \$500
 - Corporate match: Brought down \$1k
 - Run for RIo: Upped to \$3k based on success this year
 - Drive for Schools: Kept same
 - Auction: Put at \$25k
 - Restaurant nightsL Down \$1k
 - Events: Up \$500
 - See's: Same
 - Open House: Same
 - Community
 - Harvest Fest: Break even (goal is not to make money)
 - Spirit Wear: Break even
 - Rebates:
 - Lifetouch: Down \$500
 - Other rebates: Same. Did receive Box Tops, but not enough to change this.
 - Interest: Zero-ing out
 - Expenses:
 - School Support:
 - Class funds: Decrease to adjust for # of faculty + gave more to new hires this year
 - Palace Arts: Same
 - Book funds, dropped by \$200
 - Supply cart: Dropped by \$1500
 - Headphones: Dropped by \$2k; not planning on ordering for everyone just need a refresh
 - Expectation charts: Done, so removing line item
 - Student Enrichment
 - Core Support: same
 - Periodicals: Same
 - Beautification: Dropped by \$1k
 - STEAM: Same
 - Math supplements: Same

- Science Fair: \$200
- Cultural Day: Same, hasn't come to fruition yet.
- Curriculum shed, playworks, art teacher, all removed
- Friends Club: Added \$500
- Recess equipment: New for next year, \$500. Separate from PE equipment
- Field trips: Keeping at \$2k; needs better marketing w/ teachers
- Staff enrichment:
 - Release time: Same
 - Professional development: Same in case anyone needs hotel stays, etc.
 - Materials/ PE Training: Same
 - Staff appreciation: Upping by \$500
 - Staff lunch: Same
 - Sunshine Fund: New for next year: Budgeted for \$2500
- Community Building & Misc:
 - Kinder Meet & greet: Dropped \$100
 - Movie Night: Down \$250
 - Ice cream truck: Removed
 - Promotion: Added \$500
 - Ice cream social: Up \$250 for ice cream & band
- Non-budgeted / Board approved:
 - Added \$1k
 - Laura: Mlght not need it to go up after all; keeping same at \$4k
- Admin:
 - Mostly stays same
- About 95k in expenses, and \$70k income. Have a big surplus that we're trying to spend down.
- Wells Fargo: \$180,000
- Allocated: \$46,500
- Surplus of \$108,310 after planned loss
- Room in budget to insert ideas; want to keep some surplus, but not necessarily this much

Ideas:

- Janie: Would love to see some 1st grade support
 - Meghan: Needs to do this in a legitimate manner. Needs to talk to supervisor to look into how to get support legitimately
 - Kristen: Tutors as part of afterschool?
 - Looking more for support during the school day.
 - Christie: What about parent volunteers? Meghan: That could be possible; could start messaging this to parents to call for volunteers. Yard duty can't be volunteers. Laura: Discuss more at site council.
- Laura:

- Picnic tables for new playground: \$7k approx
- Volleyball
 - Liz' idea: Don't always have access to a net
- Outdoor gym equipment: Seems to be age 13+, so might not work
- Soccer goals: Could go In middle of two fields. Can be wheeled and locked for the weekends. Kids definitely want goals for the lower playground. About \$6k.
 - Permanent might fit; Meghan likes these better for safety reasons. Might be cheaper too.
 - Kevin: Could we subsidize these with Aptos soccer club and offer it as another field
- Soccer goal wheels
 - Alex: Might be safety issue if they're not anchored. You can add anchors that the goals can be attached to
- Repair the wall
- Disc golf
 - Is it dangerous? Popular with schools now needs to be away from other playground equipment. Laura: Park for now.
- Stage
 - Costs a lot each year and could use funds elsewhere if we had a semi-permanent stage.
 - Kristen's idea: What if we put money into cleaning up the bleacher area instead? Couple hundred people for 6th grade promotion. Separately, this is a good idea anyway.
 - Cost of rental vs cost of purchasing might not make sense if it takes 10 years to break even.
 - Assemblies, it might not make sense, especially since they start at 7:50am
 - Storage might be an issue too
- Shade for the lower playground:

 - Can be anchored into ground
 - \$10k approx
- Lexia:
 - Meghan wants to look into what will be funded first from district
 - License: \$40 per student for about 120 kids; approx \$4800
- Khan:
 - Khan Mappers might be free; Meghan looking into this
- Disc golf
- Repairing the wall
- Shelves for Parent Alliance shed
- If we go ahead with ~\$25k new funds, will still end the year w/ ~\$80k in the bank
