


Checklist: Connect Google Analytics To Your Website

You can make a copy of this check-list so you can check-box your steps as you go along:



✓ 1. Set Up Google Analytics

Task: Log into or create a Google Analytics account

- Visit analytics.google.com
- Log in or create a new account
- Go to **Admin > Data Streams**
- Click **Add Stream** and choose **Web**
- Enter your website URL (remove "https://" if already included)
- Name the stream (e.g., "Landing Page Demo")
- Click **Create and Continue**

- Skip the tag instructions** – you'll use Tag Manager instead

✓ 2. Set Up Google Tag Manager

Task: Create a Google Tag Manager account

- Go to tagmanager.google.com
 - Click **Create Account**
 - Name your account and container (use your website name)
 - Choose **Web** as the target platform
 - Accept terms and create account

✓ 3. Install Tag Manager on WordPress

Task: Add GTM code snippets to your WordPress site

- Log into your **WordPress dashboard**
- Go to **Plugins > Add New**
- Search for **“WPCode”** (aka “Insert Headers and Footers”)
- Install and activate the plugin
- In the sidebar, go to **Code Snippets > Header & Footer**
- Copy the HEAD code** from GTM → paste into Header section

- Copy the BODY code** from GTM → paste into Body section
 - Click **Save Changes**

4. Verify Google Tag Manager Installation

Task: Confirm that GTM is active on your site

- In GTM, click **Preview**
 - Enter your domain and click **Connect**
 - Tag Assistant will open in a new tab
 - Look for a (tick mark) to confirm it's connected
 - Check that **Tag Assistant** shows the connection was successful

5. Add Google Analytics Tag to GTM

Task: Create a GA4 tag in Tag Manager

- In GTM sidebar, go to **Tags > New**
- Name the tag (e.g., "GA4 Configuration")
- Click pencil icon to configure tag type
- Choose **Google Tag**
- Paste in your **Measurement ID** from Analytics

Under **Triggering**, choose **All Pages**

Save the tag

✔ 6. Preview and Test Your Tag

Task: Make sure your Analytics tag is firing correctly

In GTM, click **Preview**

Enter your site URL again

In Tag Assistant, confirm that your **GA4 Configuration Tag** fired

Check page load behavior and tag firing order if needed

✔ 7. Publish Changes in Tag Manager

Task: Finalize your tag setup

In GTM, click **Submit**

Name your version (e.g., "Installed Tag")

Click **Publish**

✔ 8. Link Google Analytics to Google Ads

Task: Connect GA4 to Google Ads account

In Google Analytics, go to **Admin > Product Links**

Choose **Google Ads**

Select your Google Ads account

Click **Confirm**
