13:00	5 min	Prof. Dr. Yuko Itatsu	OPENING & WELCOME Welcome participants and introduce the research project context. Frame the workshop within the broader AI governance research fellowship at University of Tokyo. Introduce Dr. Jacqueline Kucera.
13:05	20 min	Dr. Jacqueline Kucera	INPUT LECTURE "From Top-Down to Helix Leadership: Leadership Practices and Human Judgment under AI-Generated Uncertainty" Three-part structure: Part 1 — The three leadership paradigms: Top-Down, Matrix, Helix Part 2 — The three dimensions of AI-generated uncertainty: Reliability, Interpretability, Contextual Clarity Part 3 — The Leadership-Trust Nexus: behaviors, human sovereignty, psychological safety
13:25	5 min	Dr. Jacqueline Kucera	CASE EXERCISE — BRIEFING Distribute Case Scenario Cards face-down. Assign groups (A / B / C). Explain the discussion structure and timing. Instruct groups not to read until 'begin' is called.
13:30	5 min	Groups A, B, C (independently)	READING TIME Participants read their Case Scenario Card individually. Facilitator is available for clarifying questions.

13:35	20 min	Groups A, B, C (independently)	GROUP DISCUSSION + WHITEBOARD Groups work through the discussion questions on their Case Scenario Card. Key arguments, decisions, and governance observations are written directly on the whiteboard/flip chart. Facilitator circulates — does not intervene but may prompt with the bridge question if discussion stalls.
13:55	5 min	Groups A, B, C (independently)	GROUP REFLECTION — POST-ITS Each participant writes one reflection on a post-it and places it on the board: — One thing that surprised you — One thing you would do differently as a leader
14:00	5 min	Dr. Jacqueline Kucera	TRANSITION 1 Brief plenary pause. Facilitator collects post-its from Group A board, resets the space for Group B. Opportunity for participants to take a short break.
14:05	5 min	Groups A, B, C (independently)	READING TIME [Group B cycle begins] Participants read their Case Scenario Card individually.
14:10	20 min	Groups A, B, C (independently)	GROUP DISCUSSION + WHITEBOARD Same structure as first cycle. Facilitator uses bridge question if needed.
14:30	5 min	Groups A, B, C (independently)	GROUP REFLECTION — POST-ITS Each participant writes one reflection post-it and places it on the board.
14:35	5 min	Dr. Jacqueline Kucera	TRANSITION 2 Brief plenary pause. Facilitator collects post-its from Group B board, resets space for Group C.
14:40	5 min	Groups A, B, C (independently)	READING TIME [Group C cycle begins] Participants read their Case Scenario Card individually.
14:45	20 min	Groups A, B, C (independently)	GROUP DISCUSSION + WHITEBOARD Same structure as previous cycles.
15:05	5 min	Groups A, B, C (independently)	GROUP REFLECTION — POST-ITS Each participant writes one reflection post-it and places it on the board.
15:10	5 min	Dr. Jacqueline Kucera	TRANSITION 3 — PLENARY RESET Collect Group C post-its. Bring all participants together for the closing plenary. Brief visual summary of post-it boards if time allows.
15:15	5 min	Prof. Dr. Yuko Itatsu	CLOSING REMARKS — PART 1 Observations from the workshop. Connection to broader research questions. Acknowledgement of participants.
15:20	10 min	Dr. Jacqueline Kucera	CLOSING REMARKS — PART 2 & SYNTHESIS CARD Key observations across all three group discussions. Introduce the Synthesis Card — participants complete individually (to keep).
