I wanted to send you a message to let you know we made a couple of procedural changes for boys' basketball games starting next week, February 6th for our home game against Woodbridge High School and all boys' basketball games thereafter. Please be aware of the following changes which will take effect starting Monday:

- Ticket sales will be done electronically through <u>Ticket Spicket</u>.
- Those wishing to pay cash may do so at school daily between 8-2:30.
- Ticket sales will end at 2:30 on the day of all games, and there will no cash sales at the gate.
- Students and community members may purchase a Sportsmanship pass from the main or athletic office. The cost is \$10 for students and \$15 for community members (adults).
 Sportsmanship passes get you into all Lake Forest Athletic contests.
- Students may pre-purchase cash tickets on game days during lunch (one ticket per student).
- Students who are not enrolled in high school must be accompanied by an adult.

A reminder of game night protocols:

- We ask everyone to abide by our spectator code of conduct which is posted in the gym.
- There is no re-entry to the game after leaving.
- No one is permitted into a varsity game after the end of the first half.
- In the interest of space and safety, large bags and/or purses are not permitted in the building.
- Please enter the gymnasium through the poolside, middle doors.
