

ENGLISH

In Term 2, we will study several stories with repetitive patterns and phrases, including 'We're Going on A Bear Hunt' and 'Handa's Hen'. Later in the term we will be creating non-fictional information texts before finishing the term with some poems about the 5 senses!

GEOGRAPHY

Children will compare rural and urban areas using *basic geographical vocabulary* to refer to:
key physical features
key human features

MATHS

In Measurement, we will study Length and Height then Volume and Mass. We will continue learning to count to 100, forward and backward, beginning from any given number. We will be developing our understanding of how to add together one and two-digit numbers before looking at addition word problems.

SCIENCE

Children will name the main parts of a range of plants and learn what the function of each of the parts is. They will plant their own seeds and make observations over time. They will also identify and name a variety of garden and wild plants and learn more about trees found in our environment.

ART/DT

In conjunction with our 'Dinosaurs' topic, we will be creating a number of Dinosaur themed pieces, such as silhouette landscapes, fossil footprints and dioramas!

MUSIC

This term we shall focus on creating and performing rhythmic ostinatos as well as interpreting graphic notation.

HISTORY

This term we will be taking a journey back to prehistoric times to learn all about dinosaurs. We will create timelines, investigate fossils and learn the names of a range of dinosaurs! Our Project Exhibition this term will be all about Dinosaurs.

World Views

Children will look at places of worship, such as mosques, churches and Hindu temples, before looking at books and stories from the Christian, Islamic, Hindu and Jewish faiths.

COMPUTING

This term we will create our very own animated stories and develop skills to add sounds and backgrounds. Eventually we will share our completed stories.

SWIMMING

In Swimming, we will work on water confidence and developing our kicking for both front, back and dolphin kicks.

In PE we will be focusing on racket sports and OAA. For Games we will take part in **hockey**. Children will need:
