Round 1: Song Chain

Rules:

- The title of each song below shares its name with the songs immediately preceding and immediately following.
 - Some songs are festive, some songs are not, but they all form a chain. Identify each song title.
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- **Song 1:**
 - "I don't want you to give it all up, And leave your own life collecting dust..."
 - **Song 2:**
 - "She'd been drinkin' too much eggnog, And we'd begged her not to go..."
 - **Song 3:**
 - CLUES: Released in 1949, this song was based on a 1939 book by Robert L. May published by Montgomery Ward.
 - **Song 4:**
 - "I'd have sworn that with time, Thoughts of you leave my head, I was wrong now I find, Just one thing makes me forget..."
 - **Song 5:**
 - "I still remember when 30 was old, And my biggest fear was September when he had to go..."
 - **Song 6:**
 - "It's getting hard to be someone but it all works out, It doesn't matter much to me..."
 - **Song 7:**
 - "Will you stay with me? Will you be my love? Upon the fields of barley..."
 - **Song 8:**
 - "How do you measure its worth, Just by the pleasure, It gives here on Earth?..."
 - **Song 9:**
 - "In the air there's a feeling of Christmas..."
 - **Song 10:**
 - CLUES: This song was originally written in 1857 as either a Thanksgiving song or a drinking song, but has since become associated with Christmas. In fact, an 1889 recording is believed to be the first Christmas record.

Round 2: Short Answer

- **Item 1:**
 - When frustrated with his ability to make toys, what slur does Buddy the Elf call himself?

- **Item 2:**
 - Set around Christmas, this musical was loosely based on the 1896 opera, *La Bohème*.
- **Item 3:**
 - What did Clark Griswold receive as his Christmas bonus?
- **Item 4:**
 - In Japan on Christmas Eve, sales at this American fast food chain multiply 5-10 times their normal amount. This is largely due to a Japanese tradition dating back to a 1970s marketing campaign which established this fast food restaurant as an authentic way to celebrate an American-style Christmas... even if it wasn't...
- **Item 5:**
 - Sing-Along: "A face on a lover with a fire in his heart, _____." (9 words)

Round 3: Group of Ten

Rules:

- **For Group of Ten I have ten short-answer items below**
 - **While these are independent short answer items which can be answered on their own, each item partially shares its name with a member of a Group of Ten**
 - **For today's Group of 10 I have FIRST OR LAST NAMES from 1994's *The Santa Clause*.**
 - **Note: Some characters have questions linked to both their first and last name.**
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- **Item 1:**
 - Recently nominated for the Primetime Emmy for Outstanding Lead Actor in a Drama Series (2022), this actor previously had supporting roles in *Step Brothers* and *The Aviator* as well as a starring role in a sitcom.
 - **Item 2:**
 - This artist was portrayed by Jamie Bell in 2019's *Rocketman*.
 - **Item 3:**
 - This artist is responsible for the lyric, "Come a little bit closer, Hear what I have to say, Just like children sleepin', We could dream this night away."
 - **Item 4:**
 - Drafted 2nd overall in 2007, this NFL Hall of Famer retired in 2015 and placed third in *Dancing with the Stars* in 2016.
 - **Item 5:**
 - This author wrote *Are You There God? It's Me Margaret* (1970).
 - **Item 6:**
 - The logo for this highly-carbonated beer features a "Girl in the Moon".
 - **Item 7:**
 - Who was the drummer for the Rolling Stones until his death in 2021?

- **Item 8:**
 - Popular attractions in this city include numerous historic adobe buildings, the Georgia O’Keeffe Museum, Meow Wolf, etc.
- **Item 9:**
 - This author was famous for writing books centered around a family composed of Charles (Pa), Caroline (Ma), Mary, Laura, Carrie, and Grace.
- **Item 10:**
 - Originating in Canada in 2016, this beverage experienced a 275% growth in sales in 2019 followed by another 247% in 2020. This growth could partially be attributed to viral social media posts, including a bro-y video by YouTube comedian Trevor Wallace.
