INTRODUCTION (12 pt, bold)

The paper should be written in English. Do not change the margin of this template. Adjust the content of your paper with the template given. The body text should be written using Times New Roman font 11, single space, and justify paragraph. Give an indent for each paragraph within 5 letters of the left margin.

The introduction should contain problem of the research, theoretical background including state of the art of your study, and the purpose of your study. The introduction must be supported by at least 5 international or national journal articles in the past 10 years. Do not put any tables or graphics in the introduction. Make sure that your writing is plagiarism free.

METHOD (12 pt, bold)

In this section, you have to describe method, model or design, subject, time, and location of your research (completed with map for more detail information, especially for scientific research), research instruments, and the data analysis technique. Please put the procedure of your research clearly so that it is easy to read. Make sure that you employ appropriate research method in line with research problem with citations from international or national journal articles which relevant or contradictory with your findings. and the purpose of your research. Write the body text of method section using Times New Roman font 11, single space, and justify paragraph.

Math formula. Please submit math equations as editable text and not as images. Present simple formula in line with normal text where possible and use the default Microsoft Word Equation Editor, not other third party equation editors. In principle, variables are to be presented in italics. Number consecutively any equations that have to be displayed separately from the text (if referred to explicitly in the text).

Result and discussion of the research should be presented in a single unit Write the body text using Times New Roman font 11, single space, and justify paragraph. 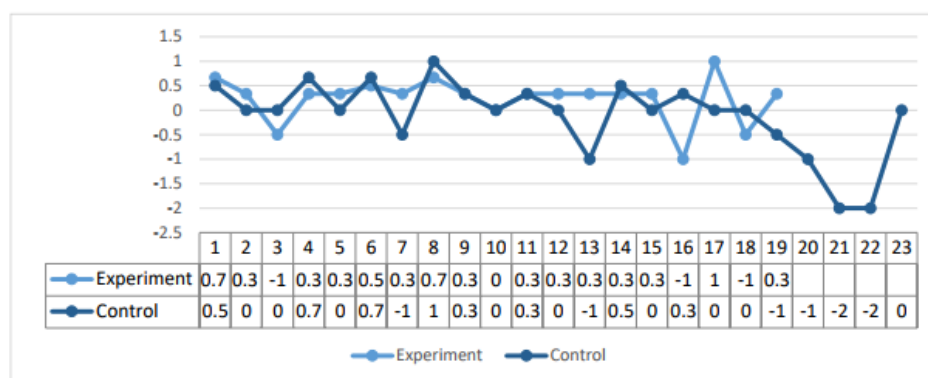


Figure 1. Figure... (add explanation about the figure and put the figure at the centre)

REFERENCES (12 pt, bold)

Citation and references must be written using Times New Roman font 11, single space, based on APA style 6th Edition which is organized by using Mendeley software latest version. References should contain minimum 15 citations which 80% from international and/ or national journal articles and 20% from another resources.
