

Textured Floral Birthday Card



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Supplies:

- **Stamp Sets** – Textured Floral Photopolymer Stamp Set (English) [161229], Sketched Butterflies Bundle (English) [163492], Tune In Bundle (English) [163637]
- **Cardstock** – Very Vanilla 8-1/2" X 11" Cardstock [101650], Basic Black 8-1/2" X 11" Cardstock [121045]
- **Stamp Pads** – Versamark Pad [102283], Tuxedo Black Memento Ink Pad [132708]
- **Misc.** – Soft Pastels Assortment [154585], Basics Wow! Embossing Powder [165679], Heat Tool [129053], So Swirly Embossing Folder [163791], Stampin' Cut & Emboss Machine [149653], Blender Pens [102845], Multipurpose Liquid Glue [110755], Stampin' Dimensionals [104430]

Measurements:

- Basic Black (card base): 8 1/2" x 5 1/2"; scored at 4 1/4"
- Very Vanilla; 5 1/4" x 4", plus scrap piece for butterfly

Instructions:

1. Fold the Basic Black cardstock in half to create card base.
2. Stamp floral image with Versamark ink onto Very Vanilla card base. Scribble yellow and red chalk on top, rubbing the colors together with fingers (or sponge dauber).
3. Stamp leaves with Versamark ink; follow step above using green chalks.
4. Place rectangle die from "Tune In" on stamped piece and cut. Ink sentiment and stamp with memento ink. Cover with Versamark ink and emboss with clear powder. Set sentiment piece aside.
5. Run 4" x 5 1/4" stamped layer through Stampin' Cut & Emboss machine with So Swirly embossing folder. Glue to black card base.

6. Cover sentiment die cut with Versamark, sprinkle with Clear Embossing Powder, shake off excess and set with heat tool. Place Stampin' Dimensionals behind die cut and place on front of card, slightly offsetting from original cut.
7. Stamp butterfly from "Sketched Butterflies" set onto Very Vanilla card stock with Black Memento ink pad. Repeat to create two of the same butterflies. Use Blender Pen to add pastel chalk to color butterflies.
8. Glue first butterfly to front of card . Cover with clear embossing powder and heat set. Cut with coordinating die. Cover second butterfly with clear embossing powder and heat set. Cut with coordinating die. Fold up wings on second butterfly and add glue to body. Glue on top of first butterfly.
9. Add gems of choice to front of card.
