2.- Context: Rationale: Cardano Vision 2030 Roundtable Talk

The Cardano Product Committee of Intersect is facilitating a process to create a community-led proposal for Cardano by 2030.

Following surveys, focus group calls and workshop run since the end of 2024, the committee is now reviewing and refining with the Community a draft with the goal of submitting it on-chain to DReps.

The ecosystem is invited to partake in a live discussion on where Cardano should stand by the end of this decade. The vision outlines an ambitious future: Cardano as a robust and scalable foundation for a decentralized global economy, powered by advances in L1 and L2 performance, programmable assets, developer tooling, and community-driven innovation.

This Roundtable Talk will bring together a diverse group of community stakeholders — builders, SPOs, governance advocates, and ecosystem leaders, to critically examine this vision and share perspectives on how it can be realized. Rather than treating the draft proposal as fixed, the session will explore the practical steps, priorities, and trade-offs required to make Cardano's aspirations tangible.

Key themes include:

- Assessing the current state of Cardano and the ecosystem's most pressing challenges.
- Defining clear and measurable goals for 2030, while considering whether breaking them down into smaller sub-goals might accelerate progress.
- Discussing the role of product-market fit and whether Cardano-based solutions should directly align with specific industry needs.
- Identifying what is truly needed, in infrastructure, governance, and community engagement, to bridge the gap between today's reality and tomorrow's vision.

This session is not only about critiquing the vision, but about ensuring it remains grounded in the lived experiences of those who build, operate, and govern on Cardano every day. By bringing these voices together in a live Roundtable Talk, we aim to refine the pathway to 2030, making it actionable, inclusive, and sustainable for the entire ecosystem.

The ultimate goal is to align around a shared understanding: one where strategic partnerships, developer empowerment, and community engagement converge to build the thriving, decentralized ecosystem Cardano aspires to become.

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3.- Streamyard Setup

Ensure that all speakers have access to the [Streamyard link](#) and have tested their devices beforehand.

The session will be available ~1 hour before, so everyone can join and get familiar with the UI.

- Confirm **microphone, camera, and internet connection** for optimal streaming quality.
- Please remind the guest to pay attention to the image and sound quality, especially the sound quality must be achieved by using **headphones or headset**.

4.- Streamyard Guidelines for Invitees

- **Streaming Guide:**
 - Be on time and prepared for the session. The call will be open for **testing** and the technical operator will be available one hour prior to the call for further testing.
 - Try to choose an environment with **minimal background noise**, and check that your background is neat and professional. Feel free to use a background.
 - Ensure **good lighting** (Use soft, even lighting to enhance video quality) and **clear sound** for an effective presentation.
 - **Mute** when not speaking to minimize background noise.
 - Avoid **self-promotion** or **project pitches** unless directly related to the discussion at hand.
 - Familiarize yourself with Streamyard features before the session.
 - **Close Unnecessary Applications:** Shut down apps and tabs to reduce system load and prevent distractions and feedback, if you need to monitor the stream please remember to mute and silence the other window.
 - **Optimize Audio Settings:** Use headphones, ensure correct mic/speaker StreamYard settings, and disable echo cancellation with an external mic.
 - **Adjust Input Volume:** Set your system's input (win/ios/linux) volume around 95% for clear sound.
 - **Lower Video Quality if Needed:** If bandwidth is limited, reduce video quality in Streamyard settings/camera.

- **Use a Wired Connection:** Connect via LAN for more stable streaming than Wi-Fi.
- **Use the private chat:** For any emergency that occurs while we are live.

- Ensure the conversation remains focused on the topic
- **Engagement:** Encourage questions and comments from the live audience.
- **Wrap-Up:** Summarize key points, thank participants, and remind the community to engage in ongoing discussions.
