Preparing for Remote Learning

Given the community COVID-19 levels, it is important that families prepare their students for remote learning should it be necessary due to quarantine. The need for remote learning often comes with very little notice! K-2 families, make sure you are connected to your classroom **SeeSaw account** and know how to access it. 3-5 families, make sure your student is connected to their **Google Classroom** account and knows how to access it. If you are having trouble with your student's account, reach out to your teacher now! While materials (digital and/or physical) will be available from school, make sure you have thought about a space in your home for your student to work and have some basic materials like pencils and paper available. In the event your student goes remote, OTES also has devices to loan to families. In addition to your student's classroom teacher or case manager, we also have remote learning staff to assist your family during these times of remote learning.
