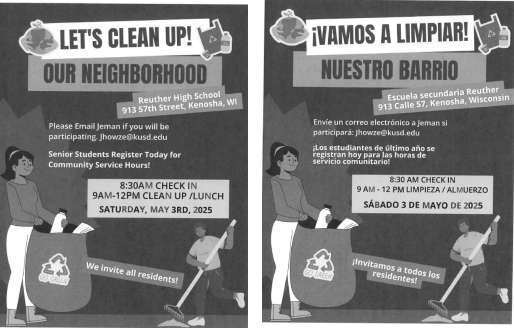


ITHSA Community Service Opportunities Board
