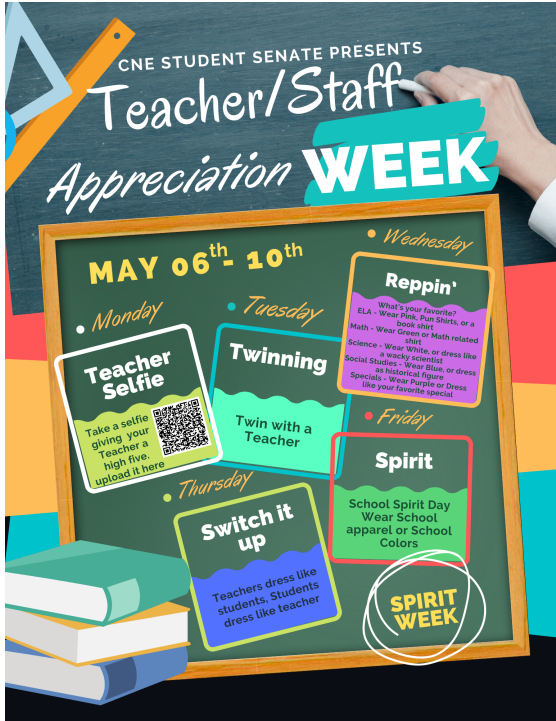

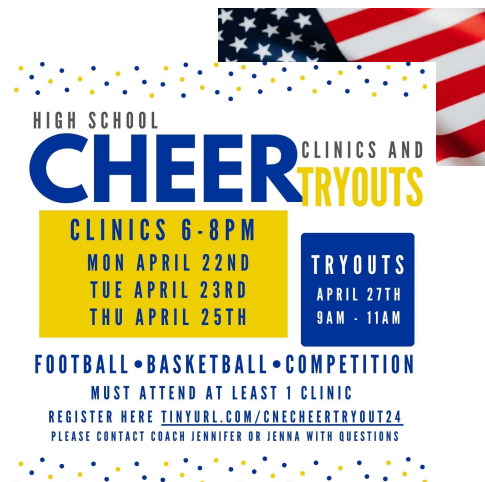

Next week we begin End of Course (EOC) state testing for *English Language Arts*.

When planning for the best possible testing environment, we must analyze our current processes and ask ourselves important questions:

1. How does CNE High School meet all of the state guidelines and requirements?
2. How does CNE High School ensure students who are taking the tests can do so in a comfortable and appropriate environment/timeframe?
3. How does CNE High School incentivize students to take testing seriously and perform their very best?
4. How does CNE High School deliver all of the testing and minimize the disruption to the educational process for students who are not testing?
5. How does CNE High School deliver all of the testing within the current constraints of the school day and availability of staff?

Analysis of the above questions has led us to develop a schedule which best addresses the needs of our students while meeting the state requirements. **Students who are testing will report at normal time.**

Students NOT taking the ELA II test or students who have previously and successfully passed the ELA II testing requirements, MAY operate on a three-hour delay schedule for English Language Arts Testing on April 10 & 11.
