



ARIZONA DISTRICT NMI SCHOLARSHIP APPLICATION APPROVAL POLICY



Our Goal:

The Arizona District Church of the Nazarene NMI desires to promote cross cultural ministry opportunities to students ages 13-21 through Work & Witness. Applications must be received at least 6 months in advance of the opportunity.

Our Purpose:

The purpose of an NMI Work & Witness scholarship is to provide financial assistance to those who wish to participate in a mission trip outside the contiguous 48 states. The intent of this scholarship is that it gives opportunities for young people to experience missions work and to expand the Kingdom of God. In an effort to involve as many different applicants as possible, the council will give preference to those who have not previously received financial assistance in the past. The district NMI appointed Scholarship Committee may decide to provide assistance to any one person no more than twice in any 5 year period.

To be considered for an NMI scholarship, a person must be:

1. A member or regular attendee of a church on the Arizona district; and
2. Willing to share their personal testimony with the Scholarship Committee; and
3. Available to share about their experience at the following NMI Convention

The NMI Scholarship shall:

1. Not be less than \$250 and not exceed \$500 per missional opportunity through Work & Witness depending on cost.
2. Be used for said trip and must be refunded if trip is cancelled or student fails to participate.
3. Be funded to student's local church upon approval.

Anyone awarded the Arizona District NMI Scholarship must agree to:

1. Conduct themselves in a Christlike manner,
2. Be actively involved in missions locally either through their local NMI or community,
3. Follow culturally appropriate behaviors while on trip,
4. Upon returning, must share their mission trip experience at the district NMI convention.

Candidates must complete and submit application no later than 6 months prior to the missional opportunity. The Scholarship Committee will meet as needed via Zoom to discuss applications and award scholarships.
