Dear Parents and Guardians,

As we approach the upcoming academic year, it is time for us to initiate the class registration process for your child. Class registration is a crucial step in planning for a successful and fulfilling academic experience. To ensure a smooth registration process, we would like to provide you with some important information and guidelines.

- **Registration Dates:** School Counselors will meet with each grade level as a group in the AUD to discuss the registration process, graduation requirements, and access the digital course catalog on **February 9th (Rising 10th Graders@8:30am & 11th Graders@10am) and February 10th (Rising 12th Graders@10am)**. The students will complete their registration online through IC-Infinite Campus beginning **February 12-26, 2026**; Counselors will push into classes to help students register for their classes. **Parents/ Students will be able to access, view, and update any request February 12-20, 2026** in IC through the student portal. If your student does not complete the registration process by the **deadline of February 20th**, their School Counselor will complete it for them.
- **Course Catalog:** Prior to registration, we encourage you and your child to review the updated course catalog on the school and student services website. This catalog provides detailed information about the courses offered, prerequisites, and any changes to the curriculum.
- **Counselor Assistance:** Our School Counselors will be available to guide students through the registration process. If your child has any questions or concerns about course selections, please encourage them to schedule a meeting with their Counselor.

- **Elective Options:** High school is a time for students to explore their interests. We offer some elective courses to cater to different passions. Take the opportunity to discuss these options with your child and help them choose electives that align with their goals and interests.
- **CCP at DDCC:** Juniors and Seniors have the opportunity to take CCP (Career & College Promise) courses, free of charge, in person or online through DDCC (GPA requirements will apply). A meeting with Ms. Mary Watson, DDCC Advisor is required and registration for classes will take place on Feb. 11th (**only students who attended an information session or have taken DDCC courses previously will be able to register for CCP classes this day**). There will also be a make up day, Feb. 13th.
- **Graduation Requirements:** It is important to ensure that your child is on track to meet graduation requirements. Our School Counselors can provide information on required courses and credits needed for graduation.
- **Parent Meeting:** We will be hosting a parent meeting on **February 11th at 5:30-7:00 PM** in the THS Media Center to review the registration process, graduation requirements, and access the digital
