We would like to extend an invitation to attend the <u>Dan Hansen Track and Field Meeting</u> at *Homer Scott Field / Sheridan High School* on **Saturday, April 26, 2025**. We need each team to make sure that we **DO NOT** have any **GUM** or **SUNFLOWER SEEDS** on the infield as it is **EXTREMELY** difficult to remove from the field turf. Thanks for helping us with this matter.

The meet will have two divisions in which to enter athletes by gender: Boys and Girls Junior Varsity as well as Boys and Girls Varsity. The meet will be scored separately for each gender and division and awards will be given in all categories as well. Varsity awards will be given as follows: Top 3 in each event will receive t-shirts and places 4-6 will receive ribbons. Junior Varsity athletes will receive t-shirts for 1st place and ribbons for 2-6 in each event. Only the 1st place relay teams in JV and Varsity will receive t-shirts

We will allow 4 athletes for each event per team in the Varsity Division and unlimited entries for the Junior Varsity Division. We will be using milesplit for our entries to the meet.

The entry fee will be \$100.00 per team. If you have a JV and Varsity Team they will be charged as one team / \$100.00. If you have a boys and girls team the fee will be \$200.00.

The meet will start at 10:00 with Field Events and 10:30 with the Running Events.

ENTRIES:

Entries will be made by each team / coach on Milesplit under the Dan Hansen Invite. If you have questions please call Taylor Kelting at (307) 672-2495 or (307) 299-4270. Please be sure to record accurate times, distances, and heights in the correct way, (i.e. 65 seconds recorded as 1:05 and 46 feet and 3 inches recorded as 46' 3").

PARTICIPATION RULES:

Entries are limited to 4 athletes in each event per team for Varsity. JV entries are unlimited. Each athlete may enter no more than 4 events. We will abide by the NFHS Rule Book.

DIVISIONS

The Dan Hansen will have a JV Division and a Varsity Division for both boys and girls teams. We will allow 4 athletes per event for the Varsity Division and the JV Division will be unlimited. Each athlete may enter no more than four events.

ENTRY FEES

The entry fee is \$100.00 for each boys team and \$100.00 for each girls team. Each team may enter their athletes in Varsity and/or JV Divisions.

PARKING:

There will be limited parking on the bus loop and we would prefer that your buses park in the main parking lot by the school. You may drop athletes off in the bus loop by the stadium. **DO NOT LET BUSES PARK ON THE ROAD BEHIND THE STADIUM!!!!! The Police will come and ticket or remove them from the road. It is a fire route.**

SANCTION AND SCHOOL CLASSIFICATION:

This is a Wyoming High School Activities Sanctioned Meet. Athletes who meet their class standards will qualify for the state meet. Please find your qualifying sheet in the packets when you pick them up at the beginning of the meet.

CHECK-IN AND SCRATCHES:

Coaches should check in and get their packets in the press box upon arrival at the track. They will find their qualifying forms and entries. Scratches ONLY will be made on the morning of the meet in the press box. We will leave the entry information open on Milesplit until Friday the 19th at 3:00 PM.

AWARDS:

Awards will be in the press box with the results following the meet. Varsity athletes will receive t-shirts for places 1-3 and ribbons for places 4-6. JV athletes will receive t-shirts for 1st place and ribbons for places 2-6. Only the 1st place Relay Teams in both JV and Varsity will receive T-Shirts. The 2-6 Relay Teams will get ribbons.

SEEDING:

All athletes will be seeded in heats from slowest to fastest in JV and Varsity. Please make entry times accurate to allow the fastest athletes to compete against each other.

SPIKES

1/8" or 3/16" spikes only please!!

ALLEY STARTS

One turn alley starts will be used for the 4 X 800 Relay, 800M, 1600M, and 3200M races.

SCORING AND TIMING

We will score the top 8 places using the following points: 10-8-6-5-4-3-2-1. SHS will use a Finish Lynx FAT System.

SANCTIONING

The Dan Hansen Invitational will be a WHSAA State Qualifying Meet.

RACE ORDER

Race order is as follows: JV Girls, Varsity Girls, JV Boys, Varsity Boys (EXCEPT HURDLES – Girls run 1st followed by Boys) We will combine events if necessary. This will be true of the 4 X 800 Relays - will combine JV and Varsity.

FIELD EVENTS

JV competitors will be given 3 throws and finals in the Shot and Discus Events. Varsity competitors will be given 3 throws and finals in the Shot and Discus Events. The Long and Triple Jump competitions will be given 3 jumps with finals in the Varsity. Pole Vault and High Jump events will be run in the "5 Alive" format for both Varsity and JV events.

WEIGH INS

All implements will be weighed in at the Brick Shed by the Bus Loop starting at 9:30 AM. All vaulters must have their coaches sign the Coaches Weight Verification Form before they will be allowed to vault. All poles will be inspected for each vaulter by the event judge.

TEAM CAMPS

No team camps will be allowed on the infield. Team camps must be placed on the outside of the track! Please make sure that **NO SUNFLOWER SEEDS** or **GUM** are used in the infield as it is **EXTREMELY** difficult to remove from the field turf.

CONCESSIONS

No concessions.

LUNCHES

Lunch will be provided for the Coaches and Officials ONLY in the Brick Shed on the North end of the stadium.

COACHES MEETING

There will be a brief meeting with the coaches in the infield at 9:30 AM.

- Weigh-ins at 9:30 AM in Brick Shed at main gate entrance
- Scoring will be 10-8-6-5-4-3-2-1
- 3/16" spikes or shorter will be allowed
- Team camps will be kept off of the infield at all times
- Timing System will be FINISH LYNX
- Results will be available after completion of the meet
- There will be a Lunch provided to all coaches, workers, and bus drivers. We will take a lunch break if the opportunity presents itself with the time schedule
