Under the Sea

"Under the Sea, Down here all the fish is happy, as off through the waves they roll." Girl Scouts are gathering together Under the Sea to celebrate a fun weekend full of adventure and making life long memories!

(Check in Friday from 5:00pm – 8:00pm; Check out Sunday 11:00 am)

Cost: Weekend Camp fee - \$115.00 per per girl, \$100 per adult

Please note: Camp Champions no longer charges based on Daycamper/Overnighter. All camper fees are the same, regardless of your length of stay. All campers will be provided an assigned cabin bed regardless of length of stay.

- Daisies staying the night must have one adult female per girl.
- Dads are encouraged to attend and may attend for the day or the weekend. They will have their own cabin and designated restroom facilities.

Included in the cost are:

- Friday night to Sunday morning cabin rental
- Breakfast, lunch, and dinner on Saturday, breakfast on Sunday (bring or eat dinner before arrival Friday)
- High Adventure activities on Saturday: Swimming in pool w/water slides & spin cycle, nature walk, Screaming Eagle, zip line, climbing wall, high ropes and rocket ropes course, archery, BB guns, and kayaking (some activities restricted by age)
- Camp t-shirt and event patch designed by a Girl Scout in our Service Unit
- A prize for the table decorating contest winner

Table Decorating

* One of our favorite traditions for Camp Champions is the Table Decorating Contest! Troops each decorate their own Fillin' Station table (chosen after Check-In). Tables are approximately the size of two regular picnic tables end to end.

1. You must use the camp theme in your decoration. You can even make a centerpiece for your table.
2. NO GLUE can be placed on the actual table; large craft paper should be used to cover the table before decorating.
3. Have the **girls** do the designing. HAVE FUN!!!

*Winners of the Table Decorating contest will be announced at the Campfire.

SWAPS

We love to trade SWAPS! Girls should plan to make SWAPS to exchange with other scouts after dinner on Saturday evening. Some troops choose to make 10-20 SWAPS to trade, and some plan to make one for each camper (we usually average 250 campers). 1. Balance of Camp Payment is due (\$55 girls/\$40 adults)
2. Final T-shirt sizes due. CANNOT change sizes after this date!
3. Last day for individuals to cancel camp registration and still receive a

refund.

DUE by April 11, 2025

ATA forms need to be submitted by each troop attending camp. All campers must be registered, adults must have a current CBC and YPT training.
