Word Study Games to help with High Frequency Words:

- ~ Play "Cat" like hangman, but nicer! (Make sure your child has a word bank for this game, they are looking at the characteristics of words to help them) ~ Make a word find with our high frequency words using this site
- Puzzle Maker http://www.puzzle-maker.com/W5/index.htm ~
- Doodle draw a family of snowmen, flowers, hearts for each word you read draw part of a picture
- ~ Read and stack with high frequency flash cards. For each word you read, stack a block How high will your tower be?
- ~ Use playdough to build words, or cut them out with letter cookie cutters.
- ~ Trace words in sand.
- ~ Write word cards and have students make them using beans or cheerios.
- ~ Build words with magnetic letters, then have them mix it up and build it again!
- ~ Use letter stamps to create words
- ~ Use an iPad app to draw or record high frequency words. Great apps: Draw Stars, Magnetic Letters, Paint & Create
