ARTICLE 1
PURPOSE

The purpose of this Memorandum of Understanding is to establish a framework for collaboration between the Parties in the areas of academic development, innovation, technology transfer, and industry engagement.

The cooperation seeks to strengthen knowledge exchange, capacity building, and joint initiatives focusing on sustainable development, digital innovation, and technology-driven solutions relevant to global and regional challenges.

**ARTICLE 4
IMPLEMENTATION**

Each Party shall designate a **Program Coordinator** responsible for facilitating communication, coordination, and implementation of activities under this MoU.

The Parties may establish **joint working groups or project teams** to implement specific collaborative initiatives.

**ARTICLE 5
FINANCIAL ARRANGEMENTS**

This MoU does not create any financial obligations between the Parties.

Financial arrangements for specific programs or activities shall be determined and agreed upon separately in written agreements or project documents.

ARTICLE 6
INTELLECTUAL PROPERTY RIGHTS

Intellectual property rights arising from joint activities under this MoU shall be managed in accordance with mutually agreed terms between the Parties.

Any intellectual property created independently by a Party shall remain the property of that Party.

ARTICLE 7
CONFIDENTIALITY

Both Parties agree to maintain confidentiality of any proprietary or confidential information exchanged under this MoU unless disclosure is required by law or agreed upon by both Parties.

ARTICLE 8
DURATION AND TERMINATION

This MoU shall remain in effect for a period of **five (5) years** from the date of signing.

The MoU may be renewed upon mutual written agreement of both Parties.

Either Party may terminate this MoU by providing **three (3) months written notice** to the other Party.

Termination shall not affect ongoing programs or projects already agreed upon unless otherwise decided by both Parties.

ARTICLE 9
AMENDMENTS

This MoU may be amended or modified at any time by mutual written agreement of the Parties.

ARTICLE 10
NON-BINDING NATURE

This Memorandum of Understanding reflects the intentions of the Parties to collaborate and does not constitute a legally binding agreement.

Specific obligations and commitments shall be defined in separate agreements.

**ARTICLE 11
DISPUTE RESOLUTION**

Any disputes arising from the interpretation or implementation of this MoU shall be resolved amicably through consultation and mutual discussion between the Parties.
