Please <u>label or have an explanation</u> of the artifact or food on the table. Index cards will be provided so you can write this information down and display it. If you are bringing a food dish, please have the ingredients written out for display.

We will be providing each country with <u>flag stickers</u> for students to add to their passports when they come to visit your table.

The **Fashion Parade** will start at 7:00. A card will be sent home to all the students participating. We will line students up starting at 6:45 in the hallway near stage door.

<u>Performances</u> may be no longer than 5 minutes each. Your child should be at the stage door ready to go 15 minutes before their performance. If they are not there on time, we will move on and will only have the opportunity to perform if there is extra time at the end of the performances.
