



Seasonal Storytelling & Voice Workshops for Home Education Communities

A gentle series of eight gatherings following the Wheel of the Year, designed to nurture creativity, confidence, imagination, and connection to nature.

What Happens at a Gathering?

Each workshop includes an opening circle, seasonal reflection, time connecting with nature, creative writing or songwriting prompts, and a supportive sharing circle where participants may share their stories, poems, songs, or reflections.

Seasonal Themes

The programme follows the eight seasonal festivals: Imbolc, Spring Equinox, Beltane, Summer Solstice, Lughnasadh, Autumn Equinox, Samhain, and Winter Solstice.

Benefits

- Encourages storytelling and creative writing
- Builds confidence in sharing ideas and voice
- Supports nature connection and seasonal awareness
- Creates community through circle practice
- Offers a calm, non-competitive creative environment

Venue Options

Workshops can be hosted in a family home with suitable space, a hired community venue, or an outdoor setting with permission. Nature access is encouraged wherever possible.
