Lesson Plan: Understanding English Verb Tenses

Grade Level: Third Grade **Subject:** English Language Arts **Teacher:** Rody Figueroa Quijano, CVO Comenius College

Lesson Objective

Students will understand and correctly use the basic forms of English verb tenses, including present, past, and future tenses, and their continuous and perfect aspects.

Learning Outcomes

By the end of this lesson, students will be able to:

- 1. **Identify** the different forms of the present, past, and future tenses.
- 2. **Use** the simple present tense to describe habitual actions.
- 3. **Formulate** sentences using the present continuous tense to describe ongoing actions.
- 4. **Construct** sentences using the past simple tense to describe completed actions.
- 5. **Create** sentences using the future simple tense to describe actions that will occur.
- 6. **Differentiate** between continuous and perfect aspects in various tenses.

Materials Needed

- The Basic Forms of English Verb Tenses (provided PDF)
- Whiteboard and markers
- Worksheets for exercises
- Pencils and erasers

Lesson Structure

Introduction (10 minutes)

- 1. Greeting and Warm-up:
 - Greet the students and briefly discuss what they know about verbs and tenses
 - Introduce the topic of verb tenses and explain their importance in English.

Direct Instruction (20 minutes)

1. Present Simple Tense:

- Explain the use of the simple present tense to express habitual actions.
- Provide examples: "I eat breakfast every day."

2. Present Continuous Tense:

- Explain the present continuous tense to describe actions happening now.
- Provide examples: "She is eating toast."

3. Past Simple Tense:

- Explain the past simple tense to describe actions that happened in the past.
- Provide examples: "I ate an apple."

4. Future Simple Tense:

- Explain the future simple tense to describe actions that will happen.
- Provide examples: "I will eat later."

Guided Practice (15 minutes)

1. Worksheet Exercise:

- Distribute the worksheets with exercises on different tenses.
- Work through the first few exercises together, ensuring understanding.

Independent Practice (20 minutes)

1. Complete the Worksheet:

- Students complete the remaining exercises independently.
- Walk around the classroom to provide support and answer questions.

Assessment (10 minutes)

1. Review Answers:

- Review the answers together as a class.
- Provide feedback and correct any misunderstandings.

Closure (5 minutes)

1. Recap:

- Summarize the key points of the lesson.
- Discuss why understanding verb tenses is important for effective communication.

Homework

 Assign students to write five sentences for each verb tense (present, past, and future) as homework.
