Purpose of the Project:

The summer reading novels were strategically chosen to emphasize how social issues impact the world. Students will uncover specific injustices that influence the world as a lens for evaluating social issues.

What is a social issue?

★ A social issue is a problem that affects many people within a society. Social issues represent a group of common problems, and ones that most people strive to solve. Some examples of social issues are economic, health, political, socio-psychological, educational, and environmental. Here is a list of social issues plaguing both middle and high school students: social media issues, obesity, bullying, depression, peer pressure, on-screen violence, poverty, academic problems, and drug use.
