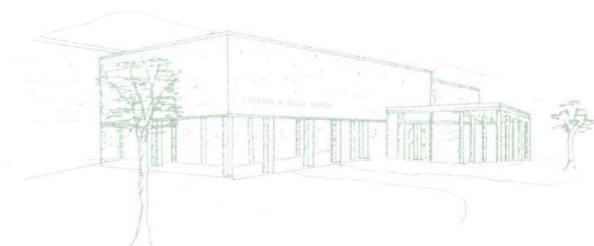

Upcoming Communication

Starting on August 14th, each Friday, McGee will share a communication to help students and families prepare for the upcoming school year. These updates will include pertinent information and details about daily procedures to proactively plan for a successful start to the school year.

Friday, August 14 - PowerSchool Access to Student Schedules

We anticipate the PowerSchool Parent Portal for the district will open by the end of the day on **Friday, August 14**. The Portal will allow you and your child to view their schedule for the upcoming year. Directions for opening and navigating PowerSchool will be shared when the portal opens. Please note that schedules are developed based on input from a variety of team members and carefully built based on many factors across the class, grade level, and building. Due to fluctuations in enrollment as we near the start of the year, revisions may be required to balance classes. We are unable to grant individual schedule requests. Thank you for your understanding of this process.

Monday, August 24, 12:30-2:30 - First Steps to Success
