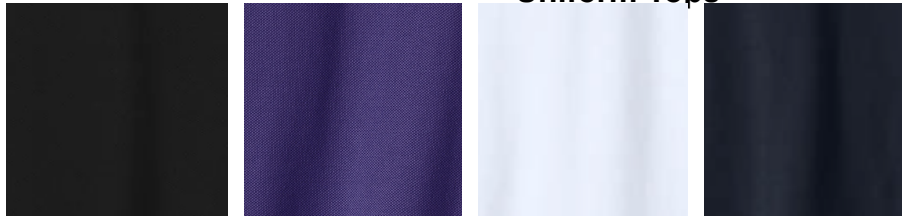
Uniform Pants/Shorts/Skirts/Jumpers Colors

Items that are not specifically addressed in the following dress code must have teacher or principal approval before wearing the item to school.

General Guidelines:

- Clothing should not be too tight or too loose
- Only HFS logos are permitted on tops
- Belts are acceptable in brown or black
- No hoods allowed on any uniform clothes
- Undergarments should not be showing at any time
- Hats and sunglasses are only allowed on designated days
- These items are considered a distraction to learning or are a safety concern and are therefore *not allowed*:
 - Temporary tattoos
 - Drawing or writing on skin
 - Fashion scarves
 - Dangling/hoop earrings
 - Heavy makeup

- Rips, cuts or tears in clothing
- Neon colors in clothing
- Hair that is unnaturally colored
- Shoes with heels
- Open toed shoes
- Leggings cannot be worn alone as pants

Girls and Boys Uniform Attire – Grades K-8
Shirts - short or long sleeved polo or blouse with collar, turtleneck, or mock turtleneck in solid uniform colors
Pants/Shorts - cotton, twill, or corduroy with pockets and belt loops in solid navy blue or khaki; shorts must extend past a student's fingertips when arms are against the side of the body
Dresses/Skirts - skirts, jumpers, and polo dresses must extended past student's fingertips when arms are against the side of the body; skirts and jumpers in navy blue, khaki, and plaid; polo dresses in uniform colors; skirts, dresses, and jumpers must have bike shorts, leggings, or tights underneath
Tights/Leggings/Bike Shorts - only worn under skirts or dresses in uniform colors
Socks - required to be worn and in uniform colors
Shoes - athletic shoes of any color; shoes must be flat bottomed and enclose the entire foot
Under Layers - short or long sleeve under layers in solid uniform colors; tucked in underlayer if it is longer than the outer layer
Outer Layers - sweaters, sweater vests and cardigans in uniform colors; fleece and and non-hooded sweatshirts may be only worn with the Holy Family logo; a collared shirt must visible under outer layers
Hair - clean, well-groomed hair must be away from the face and above the eyebrows
Makeup - minimal makeup in good taste may be worn
Jewelry - single button or post earring in each ear
Mass Days - uniforms are required for Mass days - no exceptions
Phy. Ed. - 5th through 8th grades change for physical education class; t-shirts, pants, and shorts must be loose fitting and meet the length requirements listed above
Designated Non-Uniform Days - clean, modest, neat, free of rips or tears and messages on clothing must be appropriate; hooded sweatshirts are allowed

Holy Family Spirit Days - spirit wear from Holy Family, Notre Dame Academy, and St. Norbert College (CatholicLink Schools) can be worn with uniform bottoms

NUT Passes (No Uniform Today) - NUT passes are sold at Back to School Night and grant monthly designated dress down days for the child the pass was purchased for; watch the school newsletter for NUT pass dates
